Ridley Creek State Park Trail

Pennsylvania



The Ridley Creek State Park Trail loops for 4.7 miles through the Park, encompassing over 2,600 acres of woodlands and meadows.



The Colonial Pennsylvania Plantation is also located on the park grounds. A working farm for over 300 years, the plantation reflects life on a Delaware County farm before the American Revolution.

The Ridley Creek State Park Trail loops for 4.7 miles through the Park, encompassing over 2,600 acres of woodlands and meadows. The paved, multi-use trail runs along Sycamore Mills and Forge roads and is open to various uses.

About the Route

The Ridley Creek State Park Trail travels along the tranquil, woodsy route, with many opportunities to stop at picnic areas and beautiful waterfalls located in stunning natural settings. In addition, there are over 13 miles of hiking trails and almost 5 miles of horseback riding paths. Be sure to explore the formal gardens near the park office, a popular attraction and wedding site.
