Setauket-Port Jefferson Station Greenway Trail

New York



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The Setauket-Port Jefferson Station Greenway Trail stretches just over 3 miles along Long Island's north shore. Construction was completed in two phases with the first trail section opening in 2009 and the subsequent phase opening in 2014.

Sometimes more simply referred to as the Setauket Greenway, the paved route ties together scenic old growth forest, farmland, meadows, business districts, the Stony Brook University campus, and county parks.

Less than a mile east of the Setauket Greenway, a future rail-trail project is underway, which will stretch 10 miles from Port Jefferson Station to the hamlet of Wading River. The new pathway will tie together six communities, schools, and parks.

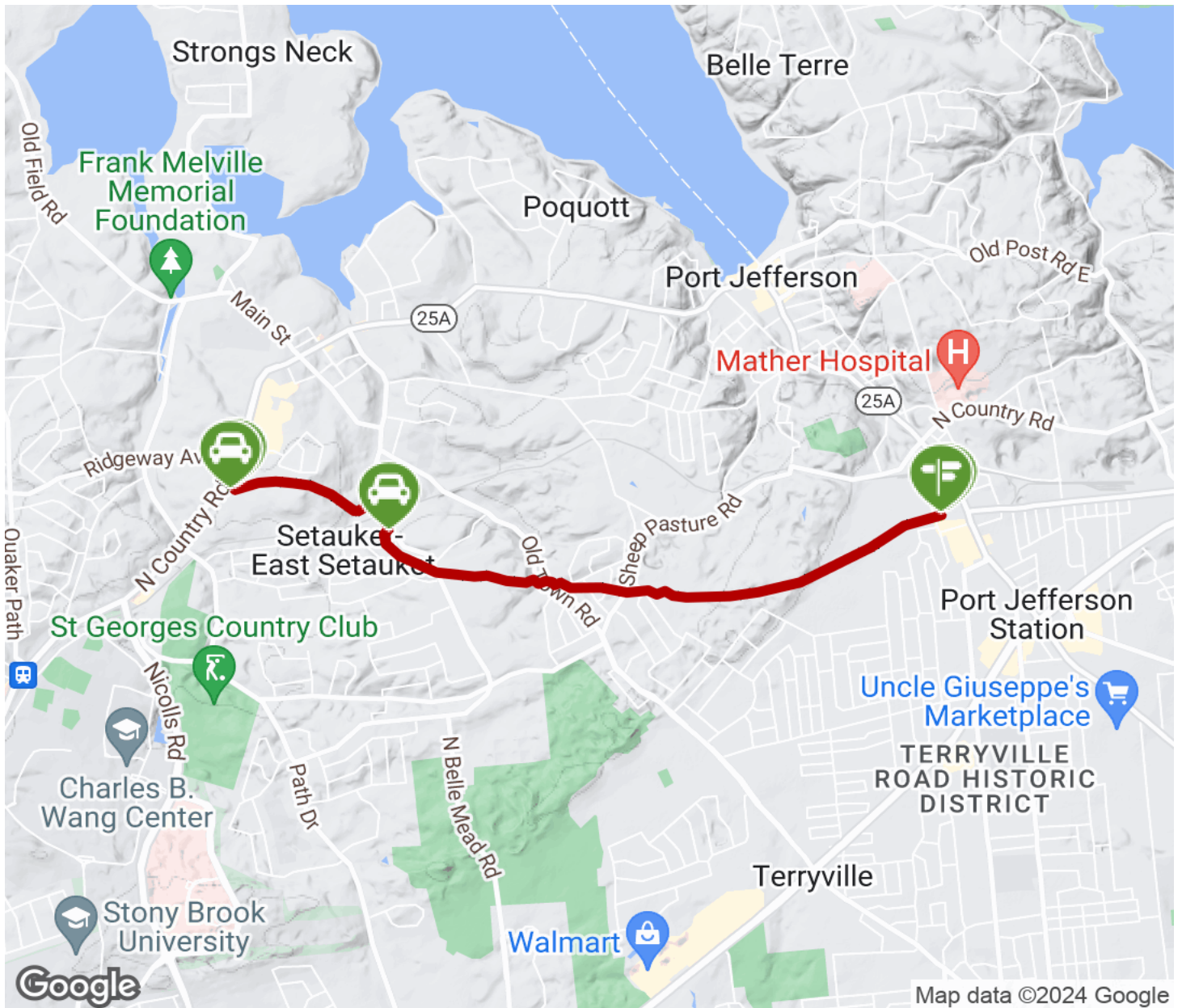
Parking & Trail Access

From I-495, take Nicolls Road (Route 97) north to Route 25A. Take a right on Route 25A and travel approximately a half mile to Limroy Lane. Turn right on Limroy Lane; the parking lot and trail entrance will be on left.
