The Setauket-Port Jefferson Station Greenway Trail stretches just over 3 miles along Long Island's north shore. Sometimes more



The Setauket-Port Jefferson Station Greenway Trail stretches just over 3 miles along Long Island's north shore.

Sometimes more simply referred to as the Setauket Greenway, the paved route ties together scenic old-growth forests, farmland, meadows, business districts, the Stony Brook University campus, and county parks.

About the Route

The route is mostly wooded, although there are frequent road crossings as the midpoint of the trail crosses through a tangle of neighborhood streets. There are also brief spots of sun as the trail passes across a utility corridor and neighboring sand pits.


