Hamestring Creek Trail

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The Hamestring Creek Trail is a developing path along its namesake waterway in western Fayetteville. Unusually, the trail currently dead-ends at both termini, with access only available from W. Marigold Drive (near the trail's northern end). The western end is awaiting a further extension along the creek, while the eastern end will eventually tie-in to a future portion of the [Shiloh Trail](#).

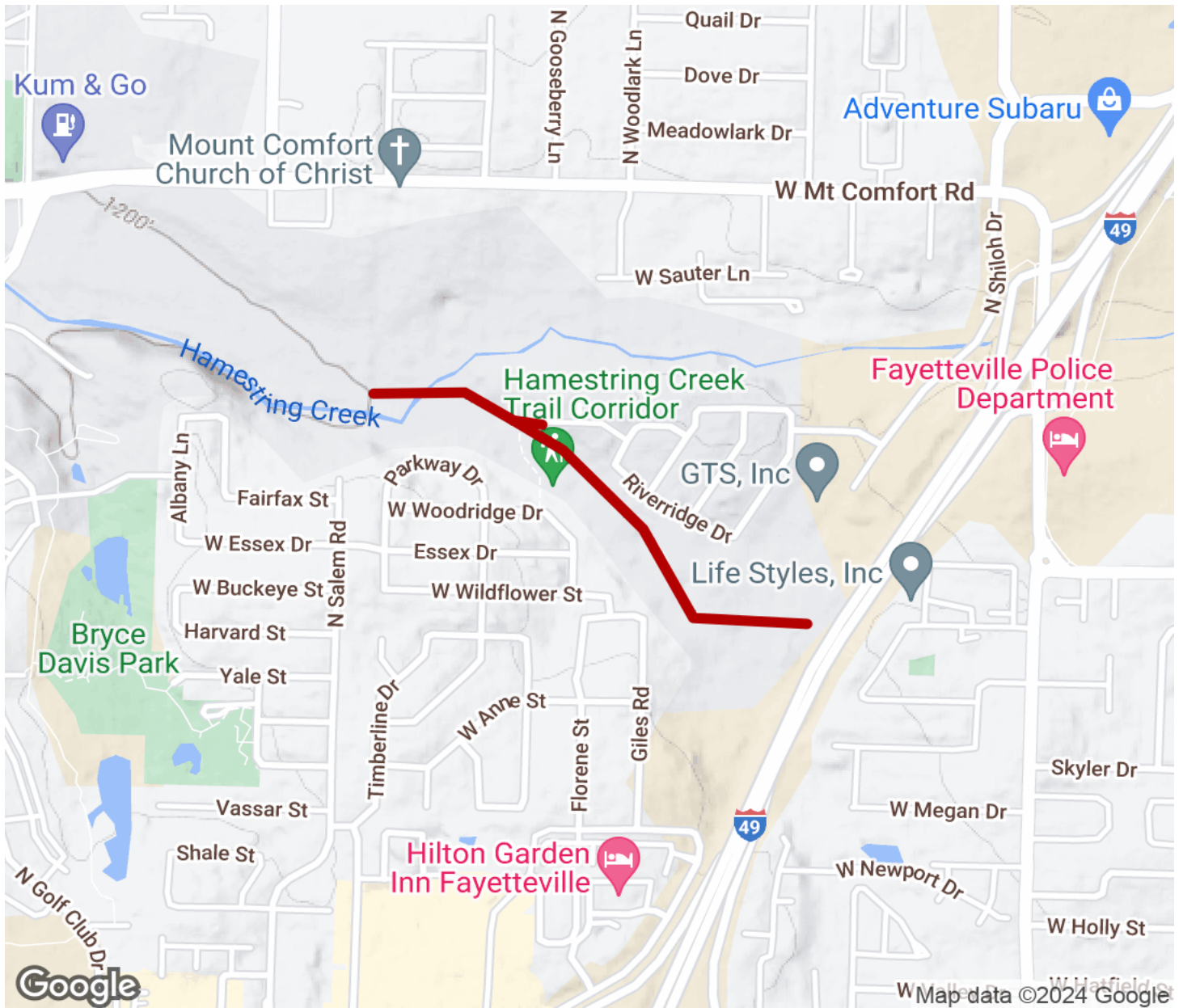
Parking & Trail Access
