Currently, the paved trail begins at Upper State Road in New Britain Borough and heads southeast, paralleling a wooded creek, to connect to the <u>202 Parkway Trail</u>. Both trails are part of large system of trails spanning a whopping 750 miles in the Philadelphia and Camden area called The Circuit.
