The Dan Yersavich Memorial Bikeway closely follows Old Spanish Trail, a road that connects residential areas of Tucson with Saguaro National Park, for its entire route. Compared to some of the other wide, well-maintained trails in the area, this path may be a bit of a disappointment, but it is still an incredibly useful route for locals and visitors alike.

The trail ends at the visitor center for Saguaro National Park's Rincon Mountain District. Be sure to visit the center, which is open year-round (except Christmas day), to view a selection of resources, and consider taking the self-guided walk just outside to learn about local flora. Mountain biking and hiking trails are also available within the park.

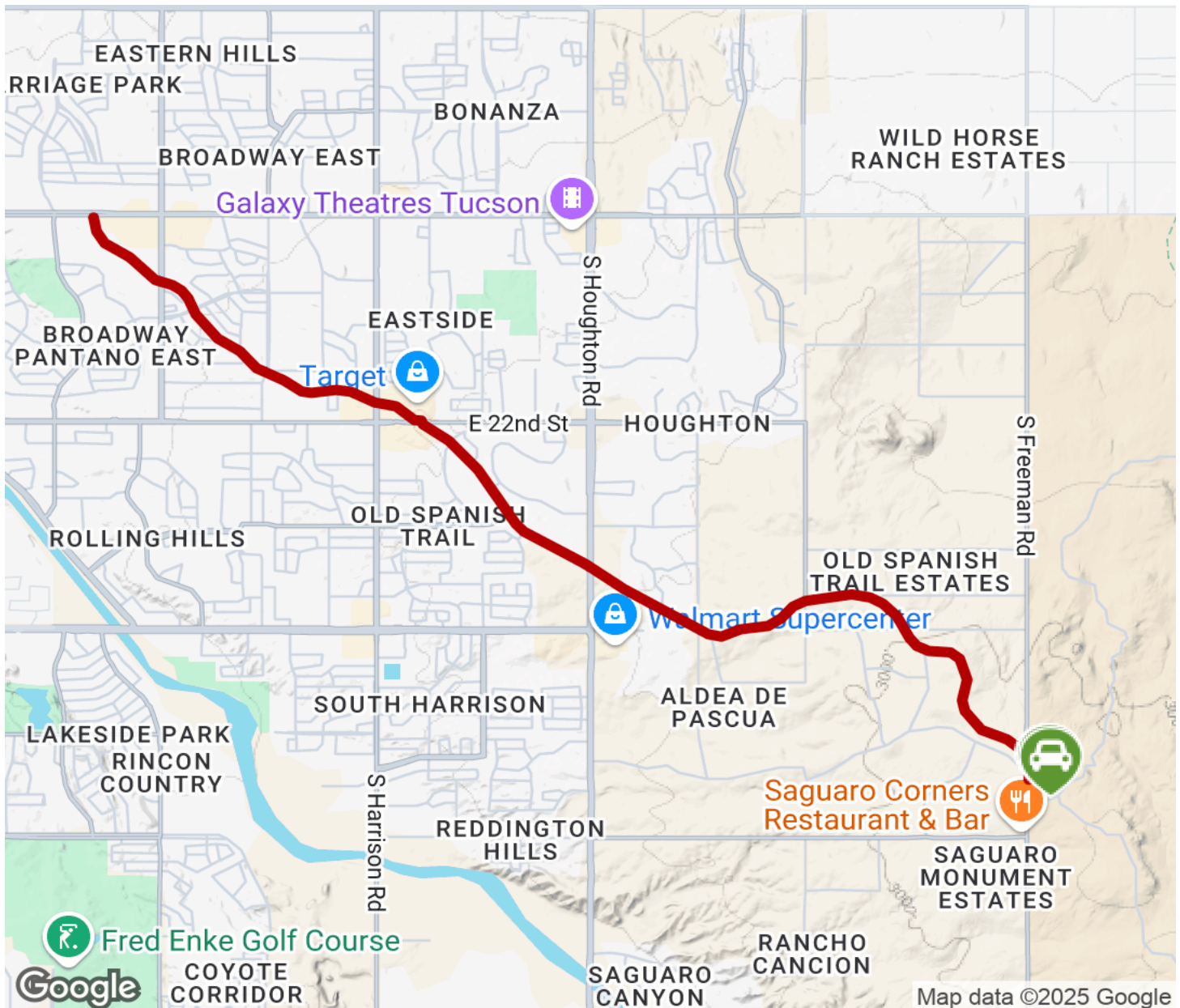
Parking & Trail Access
