Only a tiny portion of the El Paso & Southwestern Greenway is currently open in Tucson. Built as part of the development of the city's Fire Central building (a large and modern fire station that replaced an earlier station nearby), the paved trail primarily serves as an example of what the planned trail extensions will look like.

Eventually, the El Paso & Southwestern Greenway will continue both north and south on a former El Paso & Southwestern Railroad corridor, connecting downtown Tucson with the community of South Tucson and the Kino Sports Complex via a 6-mile route.

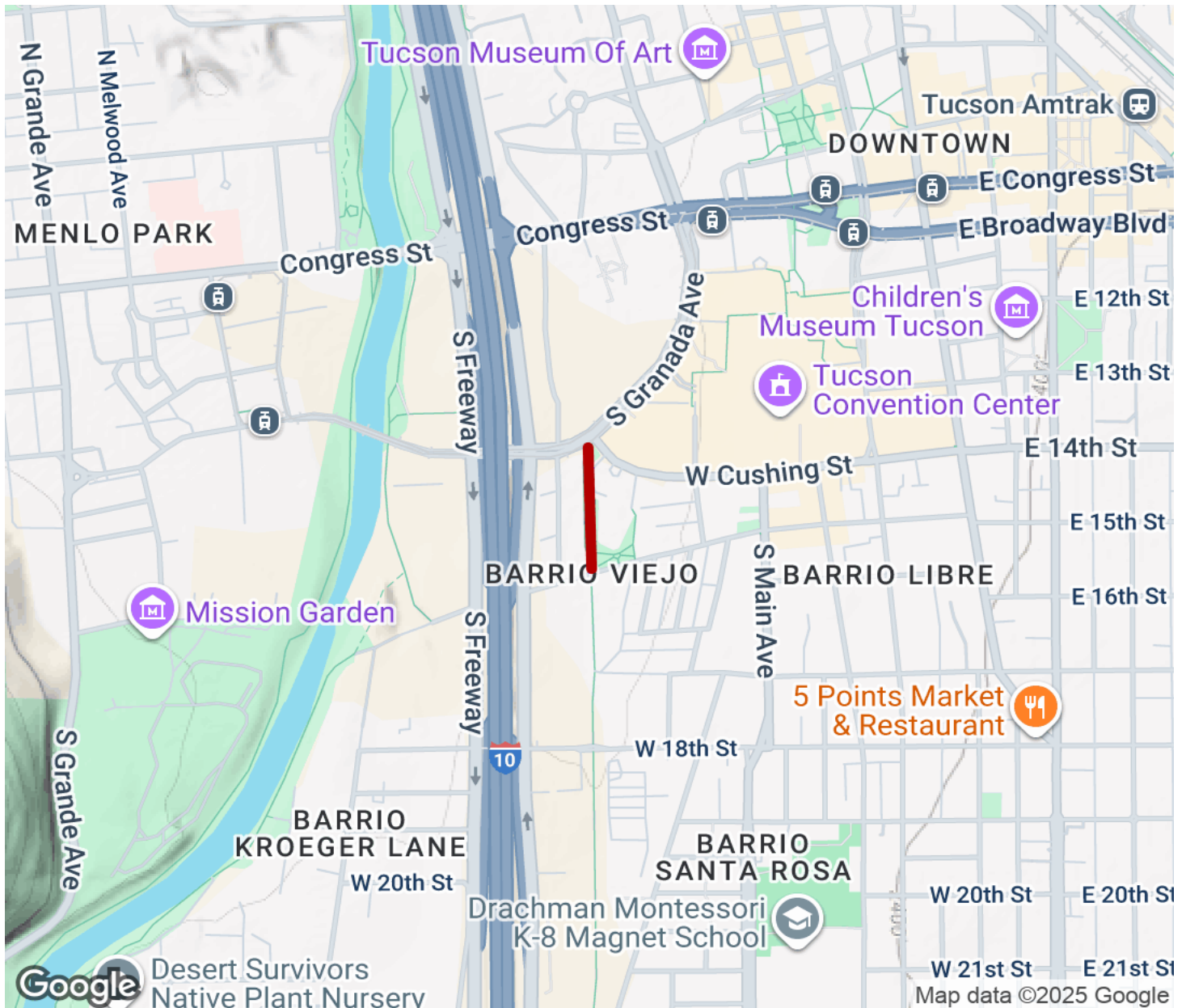
Parking & Trail Access
