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The El Paso & Southwestern Greenway runs for 1.7 miles through western Tucson. Built as part of the development of the city's Fire Central building (a large and modern fire station that replaced an earlier station nearby), the paved trail connects residential and commercial areas.

There are no official parking areas for the open portion of the El Paso & Southwestern Greenway, but ample parking is available along local streets. Be sure to obey any posted parking restrictions.



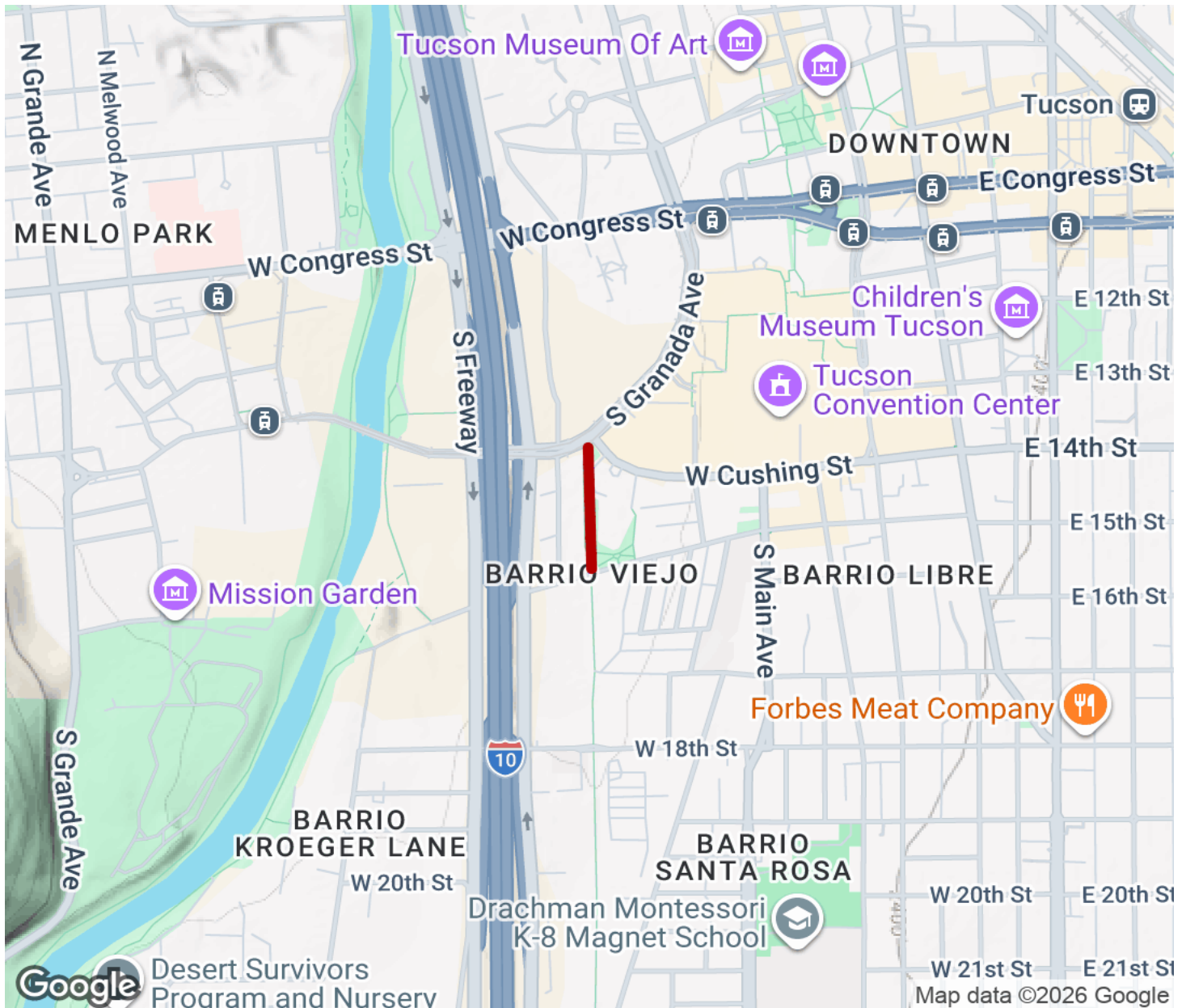
