Highway 89 South Pedestrian Trail

Montana



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The Highway 89 South Pedestrian Trail begins south of downtown Livingston and parallels U.S. Highway 89 for 3.8 miles. A wide grassy median separates the paved pathway from the roadway and the surrounding views are undeniably rural; you'll be traveling through open fields with forested foothills off in the distance to either side. The trail also loosely follows the Yellowstone River.

One day, the trail is hoped to extend farther south to Gardiner at the doorstep to Yellowstone National Park.

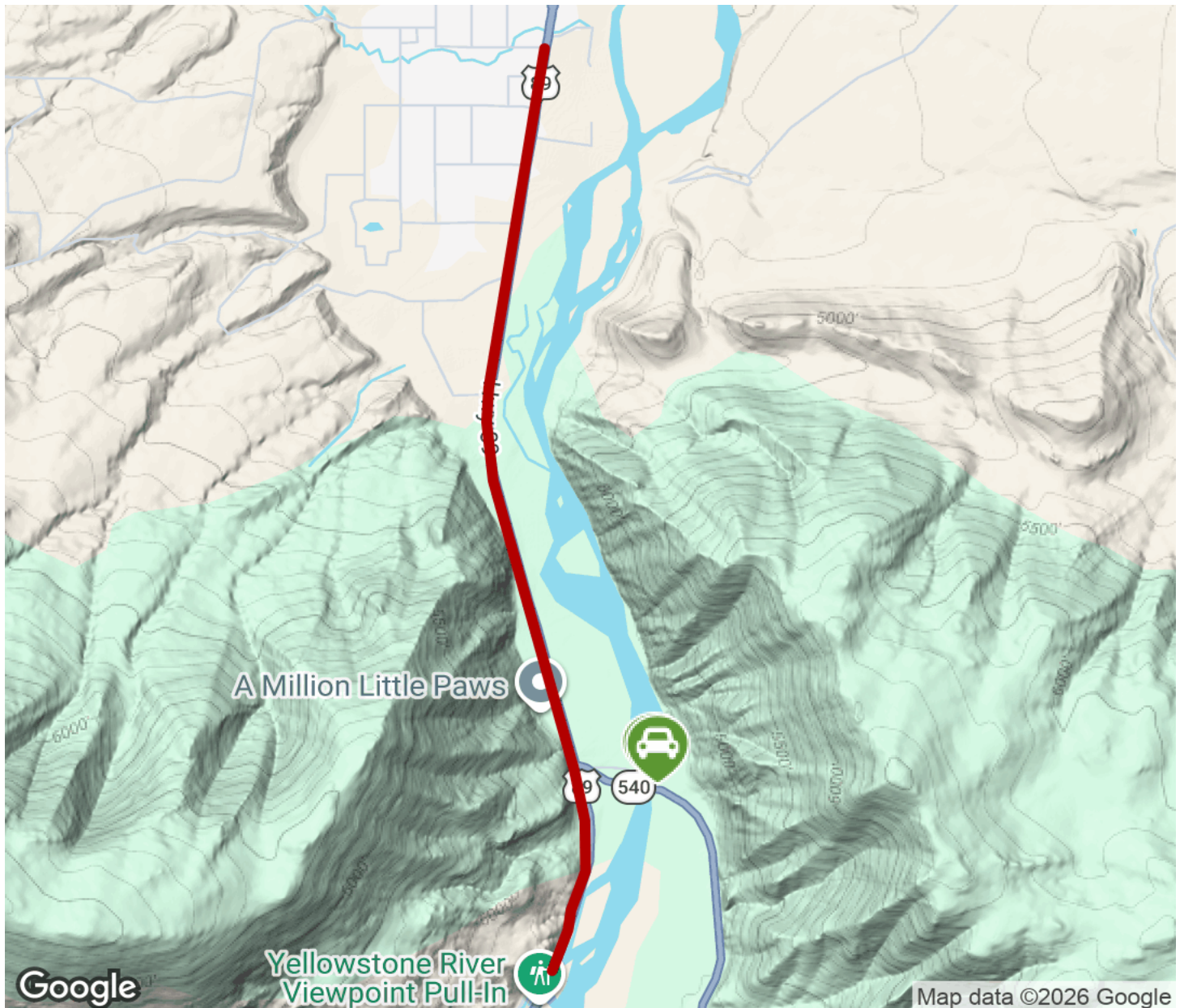
Parking & Trail Access
