Union Pacific Recreation Path Illinois



The Union Pacific Recreation Path offers a short route through the Village of Lincolnwood's east side between Devon and Touhy



The Union Pacific Recreation Path offers a short route through the Village of Lincolnwood's east side between Devon and Touhy avenues. Following the former Union Pacific Railroad, the rail-trail offers a paved pathway with a 2-foot gravel shoulder on each side. While the northern end of the trail is in a busy commercial area, as you head south, the trail gets quieter and residential.

The south end of the trail is just east of another rail-trail, the <u>Valley Line Trail</u>, which begins on Devon Avenue and heads south for a mile.
