Westport Dunes Trail, sometimes referred to as the Westport Light Trail, offers a scenic ride of just over 2 miles on Washington's



Westport Dunes Trail, sometimes referred to as the Westport Light Trail, offers a scenic ride of just over 2 miles on Washington's northwest coastline. As the paved trail winds through two state parks—Westport Light and Westhaven—it offers views of sand dunes, beaches, and the Pacific Ocean.

The north end of the trail ends at Westhaven Drive, where you'll find a marina, the Westport Maritime Museum, and several restaurant options (especially for seafood connoisseurs, naturally).


Parking & Trail Access
