Parking & Trail Access

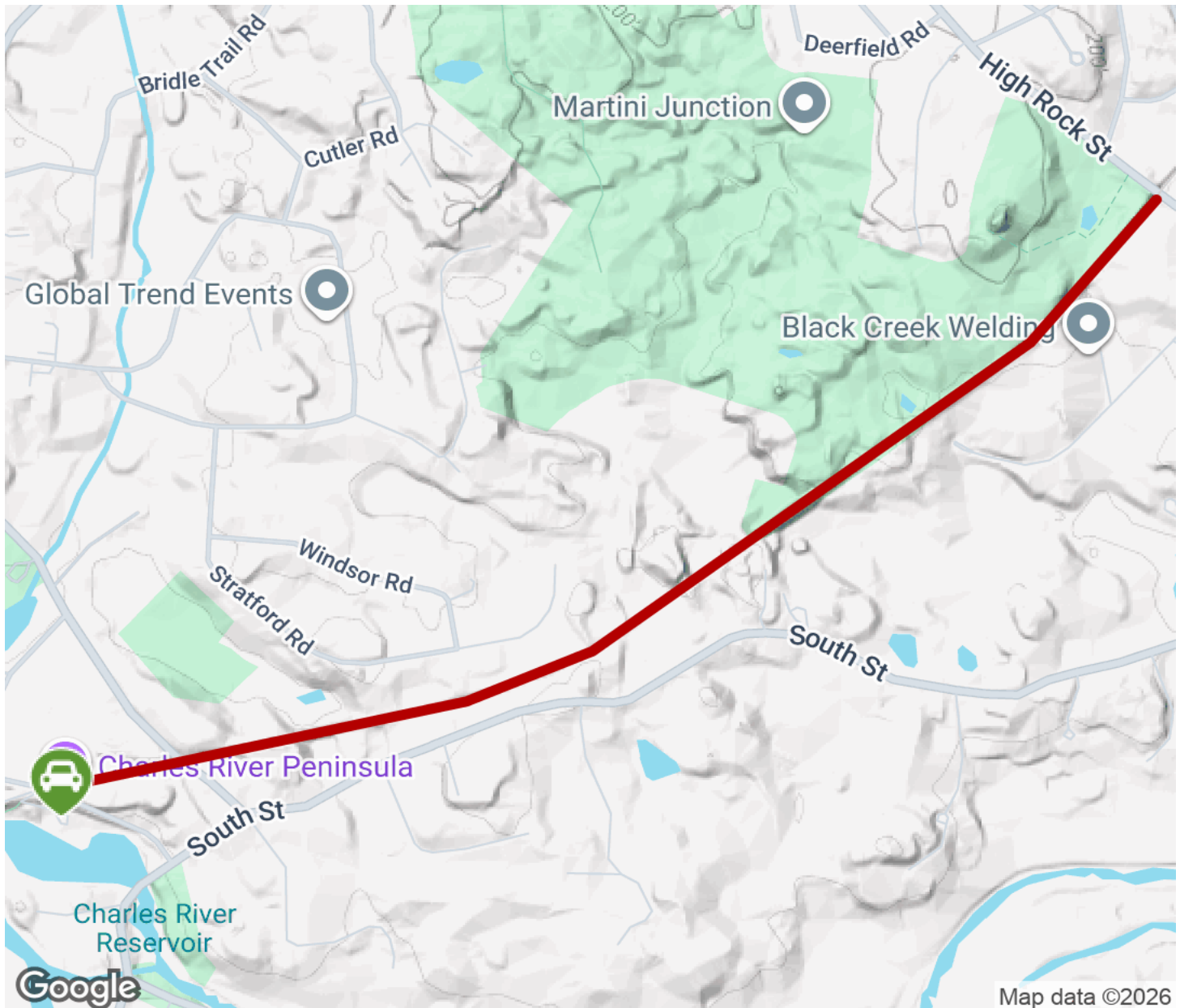
The Needham Rail Trail runs between the Charles River (Needham) and 7 Russell Rd. (Needham Junction), where parking is available.
