Parking for the Oswego Prairie Trail is available at Farmington Lakes Park (Farmington Lakes Drive off Douglas Road) in Oswego.



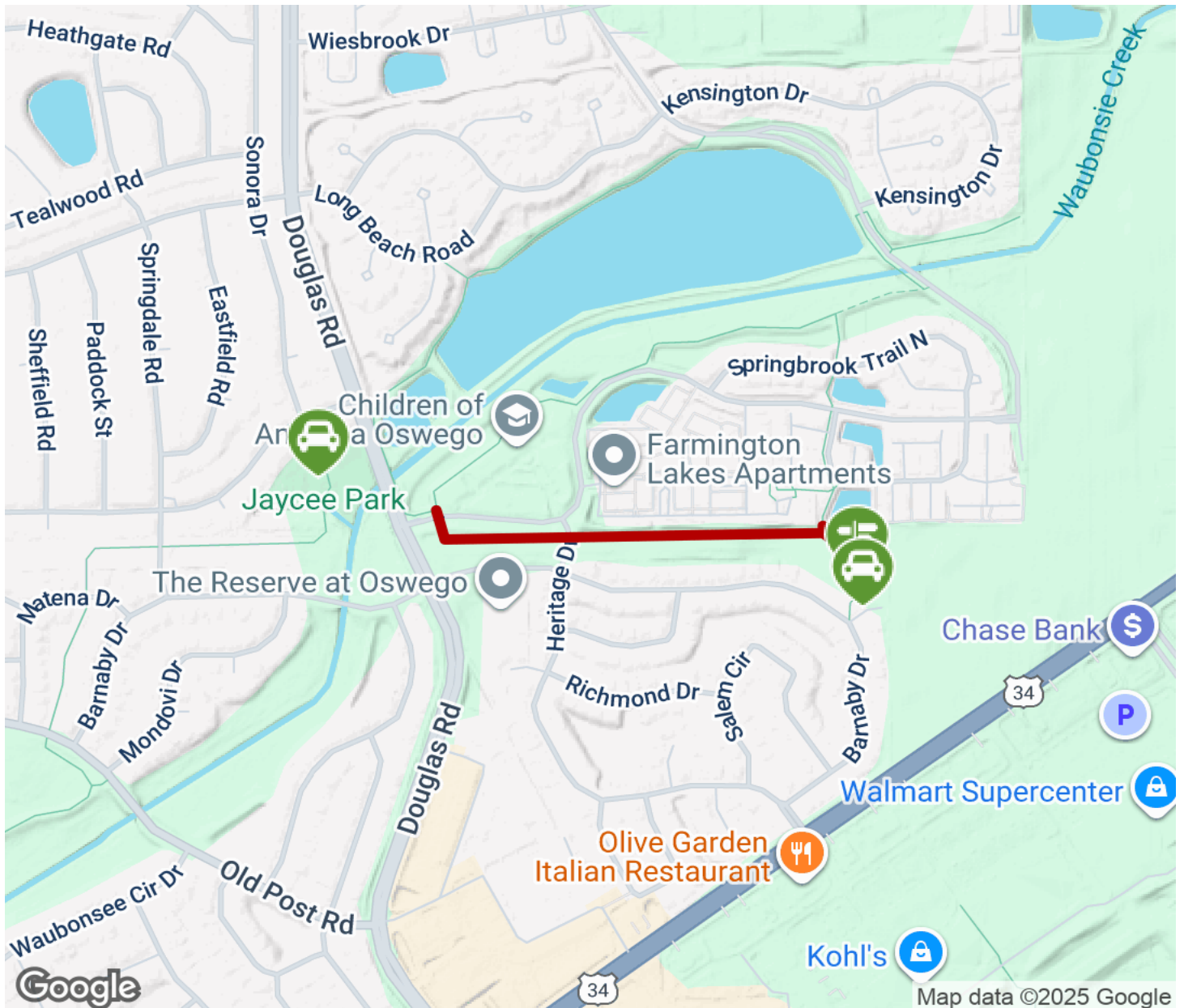
