The Prairie Point Trail is a scenic neighborhood route that connects twice to the longer <u>Grove Road Trail</u>. While never far from houses, the trail offers surprising scenery, including a stretch along a pond south of Arboretum Way.

The trail's northern half courses through Prairie Point Community Park, which features several athletic fields and courts, as well as a picnic shelter, skate park, splash pad and sledding hill. A connection to Prairie Point Elementary School can also be made here. The trail ends in the south at Andover Park, a much smaller neighborhood amenity with open areas for play and practicing sports.

Parking & Trail Access


Ample parking and restrooms for the Prairie Point Trail are available at Prairie Point Community Park (4120 Plainfield Road) in Oswego.
