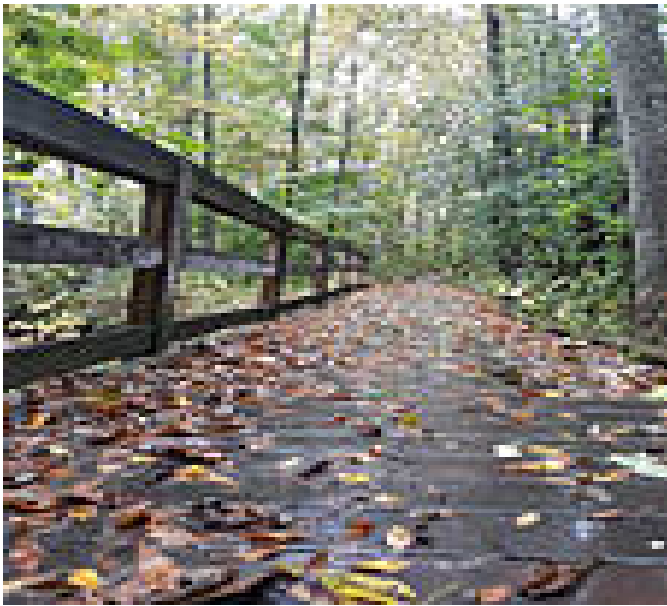

The Baird Creek Trail begins on the east side of the East River in the heart of Green Bay. The paved pathway follows the river a short distance north, past Sullivan Elementary School. Soon, you'll come to the East River Bridge, which you can use to cross the river and reach the [East River Trail](#). From the bridge, the trail meanders eastward along Baird Creek to end at Baird Creek Road near I-43. Much of the pathway is pleasantly tree-lined and is never far from homes, business, and schools.

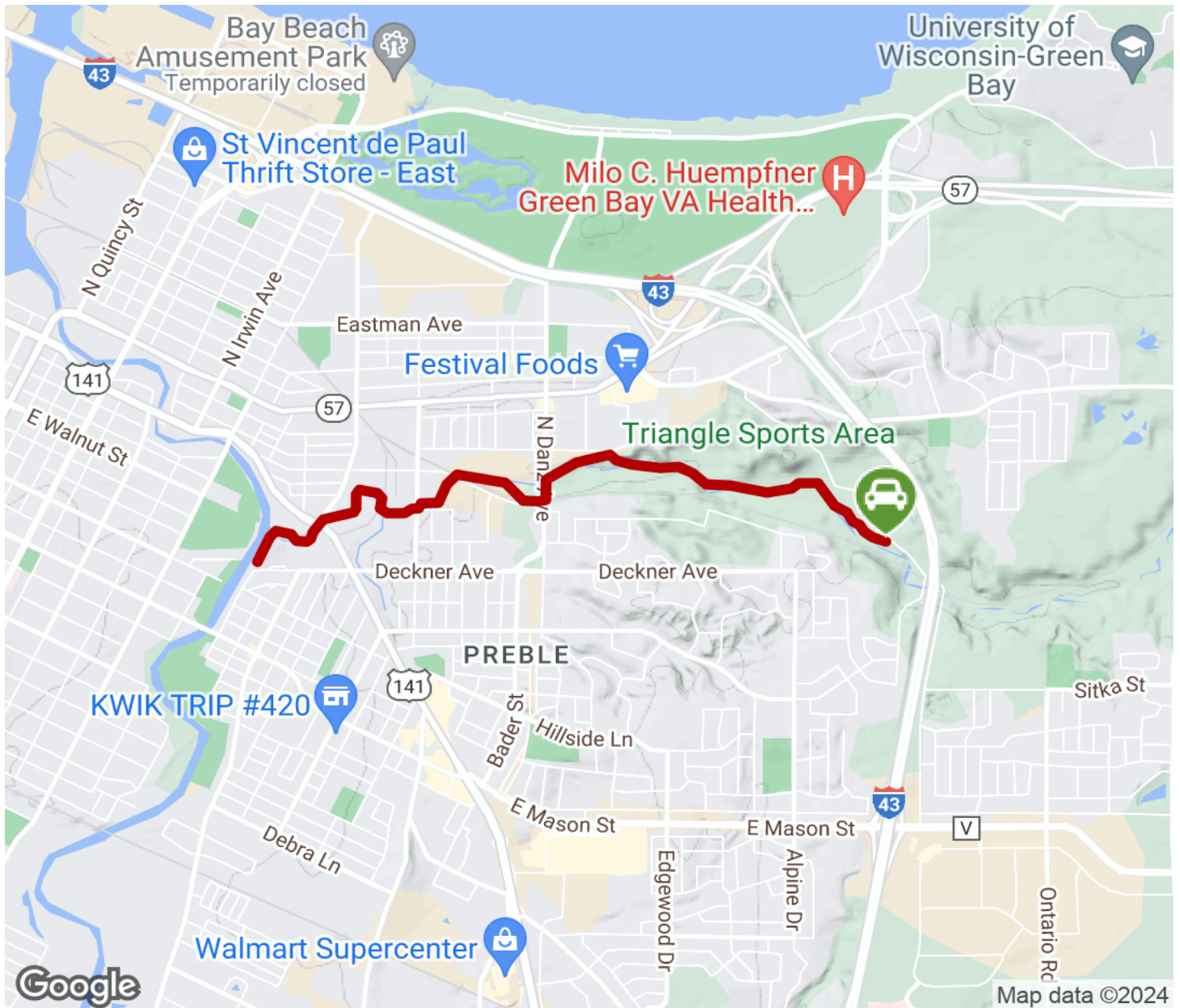
Parking & Trail Access
