Unami Creek Trail

Pennsylvania



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Part of Milford Township's growing network of greenways, the Unami Creek Trail extends from a parking lot off Kumry Road, winding northeast behind developments, to Allentown Road. Another branch of the trail crosses the creek on a wooden footbridge and provides access to another nearby subdivision and Unami Creek Park.

Future plans envision the trail being extended eastward to connect to the nearby [Barrel Run Trail](#) and other local greenways, as well as becoming a link in the Pennsylvania Highlands Trail, a system of trails that are being constructed from the Delaware River west to South Mountain.

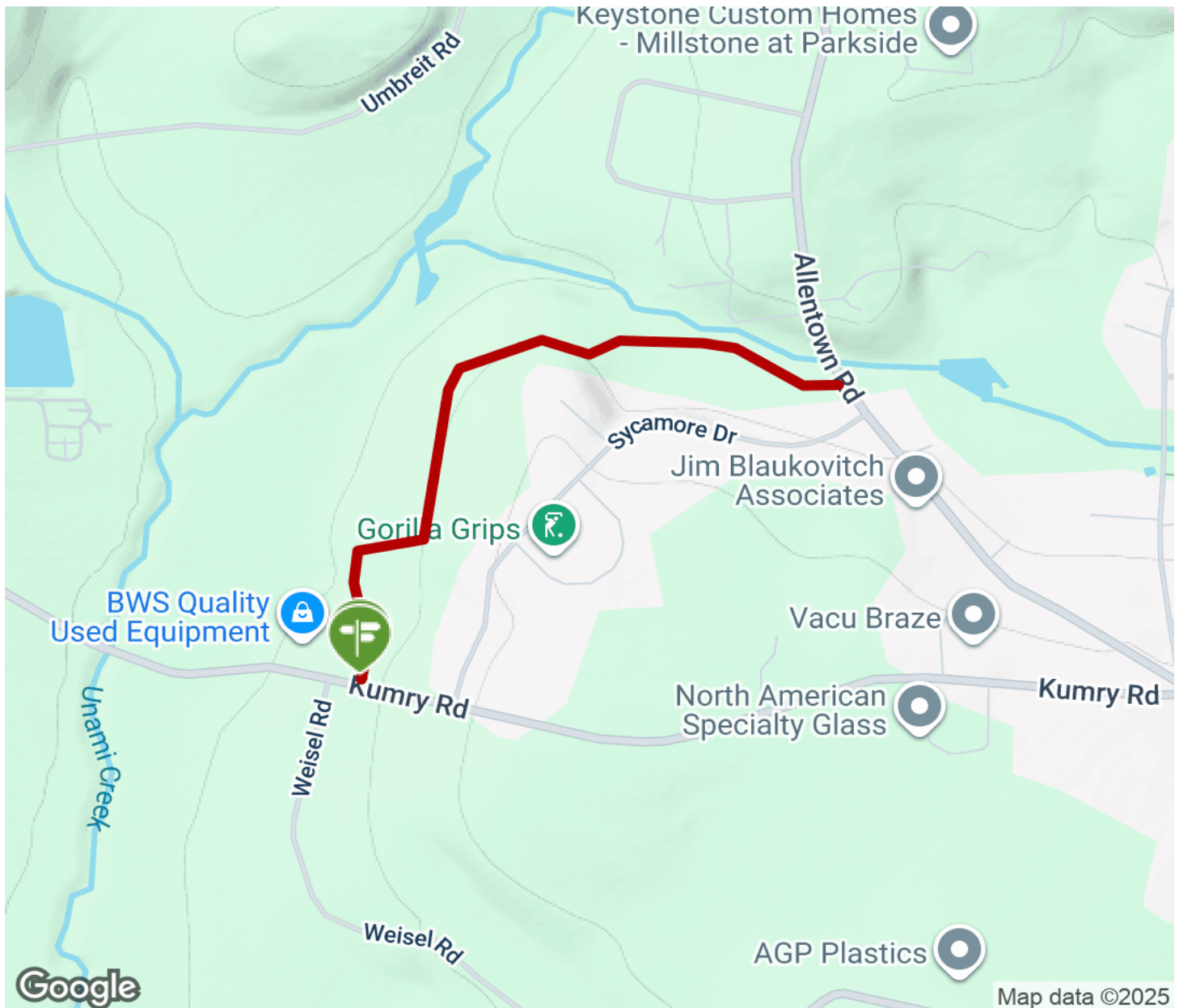
Parking & Trail Access
