A little less than a mile long, the Barrel Run Trail is part of Milford Township's growing system of multi-use trails. The paved, asphalt trail begins at Woodview Drive, immediately west of Trumbauersville Elementary School, and follows a stream west, behind adjacent developments, to Creamery Road. Most of this land is wooded, and the trail is a great place to enjoy nature.

The township eventually plans to extend the trail further west to connect to the [Unami Creek Trail](#), and there are also ongoing efforts to join it to a longer network of trails that will span the Pennsylvania Highlands Region from the Delaware River west to South Mountain.


