White Lick Creek Trail is the north-south spine of the Plainfield trail system, connecting several parks and the Plainfield



White Lick Creek Trail is the north-south spine of the Plainfield trail system, connecting several parks and the Plainfield Recreation and Aquatics Center. On its northern end, the trail meets the <u>Vandalia Trail</u> in Franklin Park. From there, the paved pathway heads south, paralleling the tree-lined banks of its namesake creek, for 3.5 miles before ending at S. Center Street and Lincoln Road.

A highlight of the route is a passage over an old iron truss bridge in Friendship Gardens Park about mid-trail. Closer to its southern end, the trail winds through Hummel Park, where connections to other trails are available.
