A good place to access the trail is on its west end at Tomlinson Park (19th Avenue and 54th Street South).



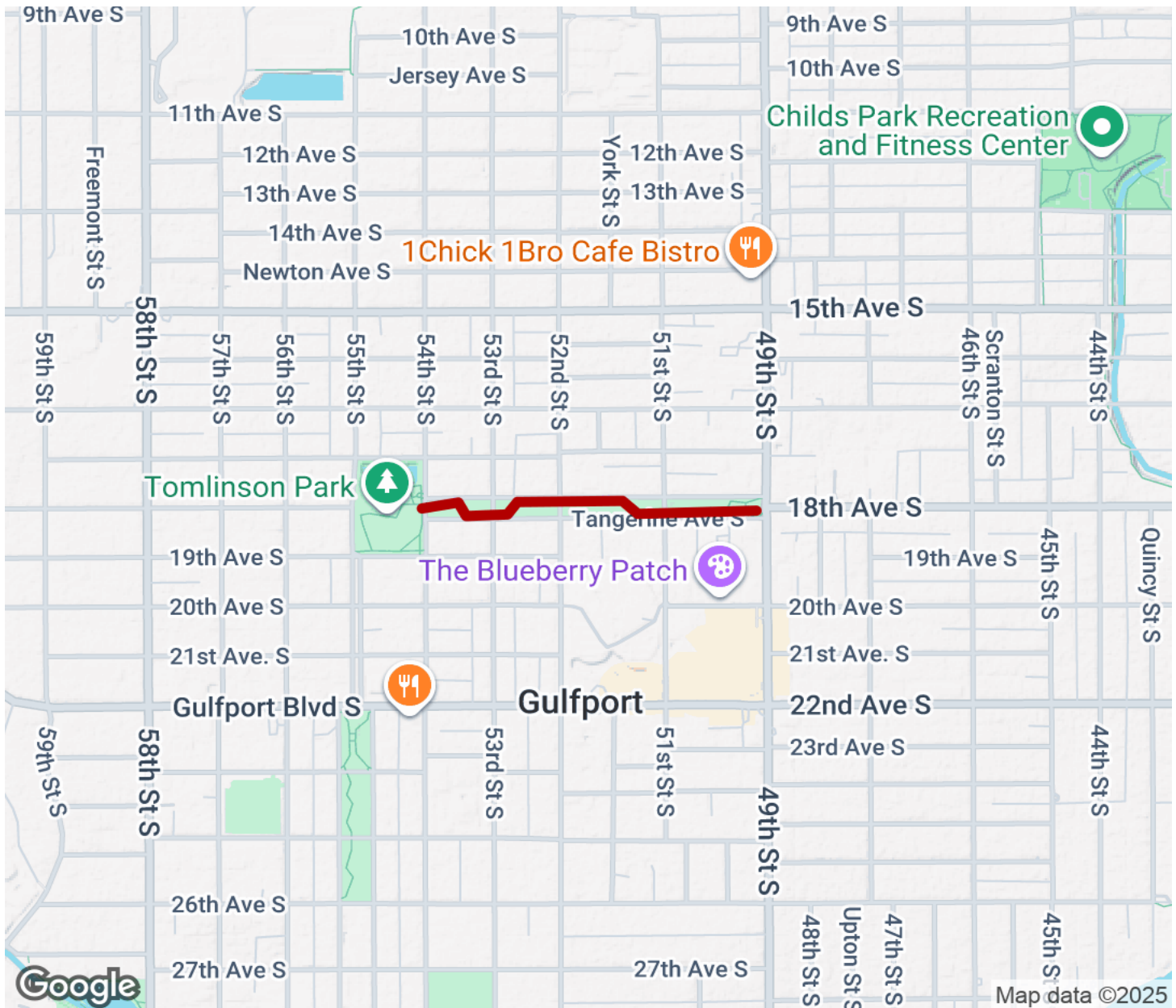
