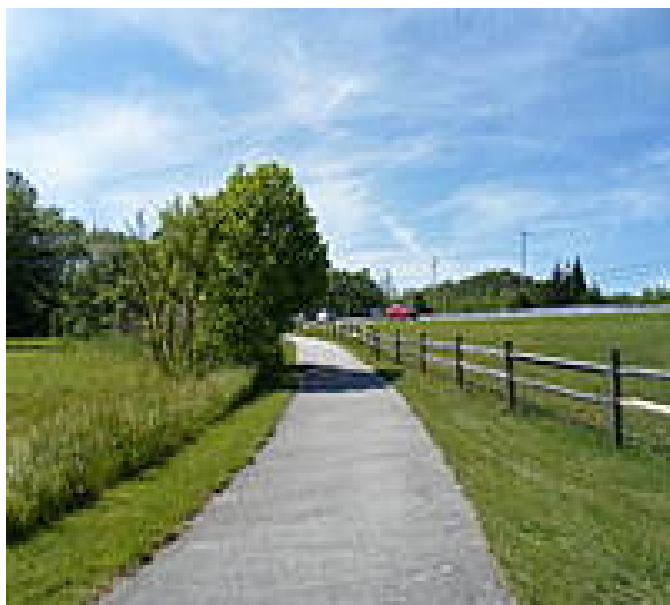

## Audubon Loop Trail

*Overview While the paved Audubon Loop Trail is only 2.7 miles in length and does not appear to complete a loop when looking at the*



many other meadow and grass trails as well as a museum. Trail users should also note that this section before reaching the Wildlife Sanctuary, there is a steep hill that is not ADA-grade.

The trail turns southwest near the John Audubon home, paralleling Pawlings Road to the trailhead just south of Route 422, where it joins the Schuylkill River Trail. Trail users can easily loop back to the starting point by taking the Schuylkill River Trail west to Oaks, and then going back north on the Perkiomen Trail.

### Connections

At the Pawlings Ave. Trailhead, the Audubon Loop Trail connects to the [Schuylkill River Trail](#) which heads into downtown Philadelphia. Also at this trailhead, trail users can head west along the Schuylkill River Trail to meet the [Perkiomen Trail](#) which completes the Audubon Loop along the west side of Perkiomen Creek.

### Overview

While the paved Audubon Loop Trail is only 2.7 miles in length and does not appear to complete a loop when looking at the map, when combined with the Perkiomen Trail across the river, the trail makes a complete four-mile loop.

### About the Route

The northern end of the loop leaves off from Lower Perkiomen Valley Park immediately south of the Egypt Road bridge over Perkiomen Creek. After crossing that bridge, the trail turns southeast, crossing the Audubon Wildlife Sanctuary and running behind local subdivisions. The Audubon Wildlife Sanctuary offers

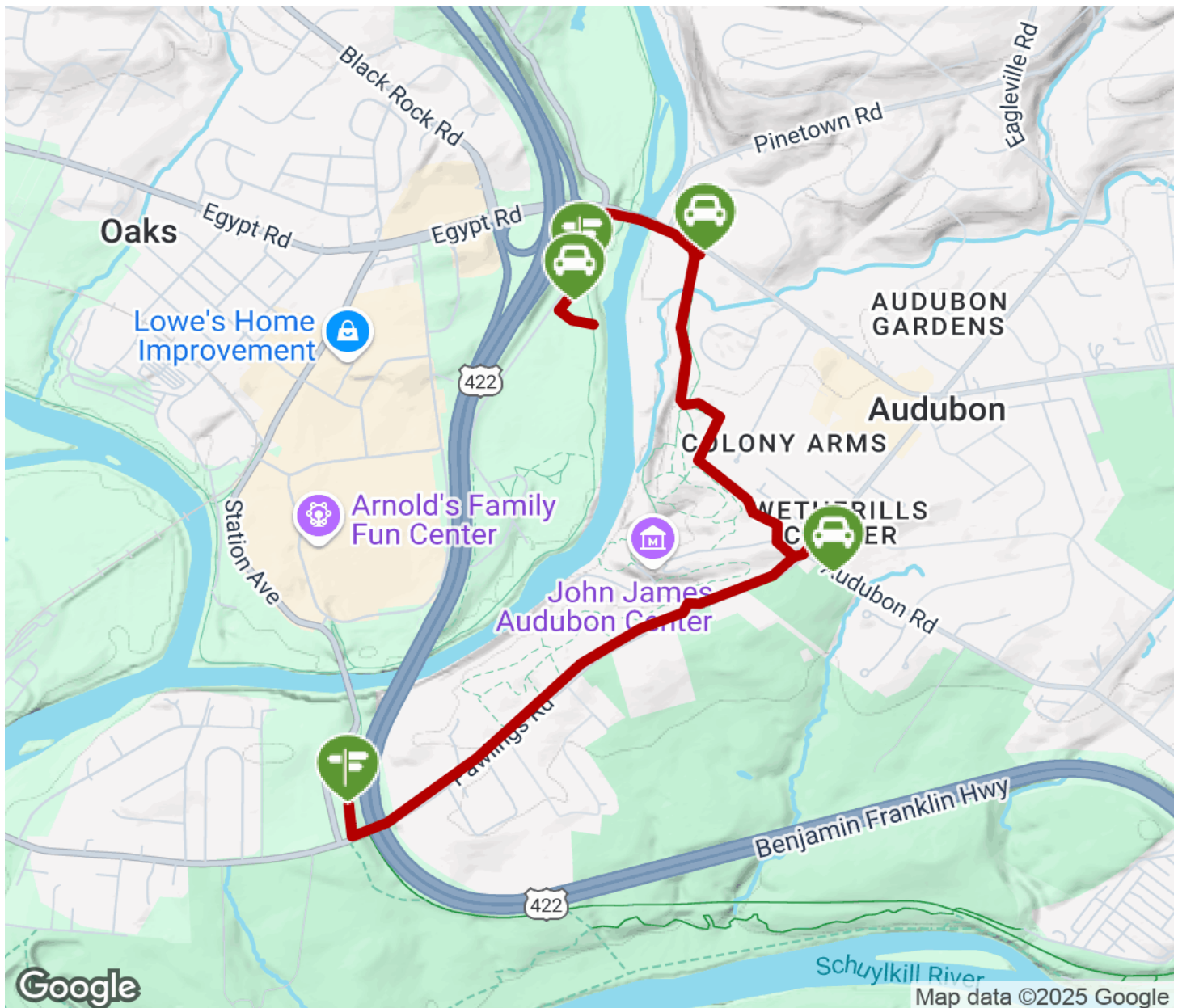
