While the North Spokane Corridor (SR 395) is a high-speed motorway, the trail runs parallel to it to provide a safe travel alternative for those preferring human power. The trail mirrors the freeway's route, down to the changes in grade. These undulations do make for a somewhat challenging walk or ride in parts. At present, the trailside scenery mostly consists of industrial, while providing some access to residential areas and open space. The trail will be 10.3 miles when complete and will eventually connect to the Ben Burr Trail.

The southermost parking log is at E Columbia Ave and N Market St. And one more is available on N Freya Rd just south of Lincoln Ave.
