

The Bassett Creek Regional Trail is an important connector between French Regional Park and Theodore Wirth Regional Park through the cities of Plymouth, New Hope, Crystal, and Golden Valley. The trail links to a variety of amenities, including schools, businesses, local parks, and the Medicine Lake Regional Trail.

About the Route

The route heads east from the French Regional Park, traveling along 36th Avenue to Boone Avenue. At Boone, it cuts through Northwood Park before reemerging at 36th Avenue. The trail turns south to 32nd Avenue and continues until it meets State Route 100 in Golden Valley. At present, there remains a gap in the trail separating it from its final destination: the trail ends on the east side of
