The East Wetzel Rail-trail is a 1.5 mile pathway that runs through the town of Hundred in West Virginia. The trail provides



The East Wetzel Rail-trail is a 1.5 mile pathway that runs through the town of Hundred in West Virginia. The trail provides connectivity to various local destinations including the high school, the library, commercial and residential areas. The trail is built on the rail bed of the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad, which linked Cumberland MD to Wheeling, WV. You can find a weather shelter and a marker with the history of the railroad, which was completed in the mid-19th century.

The little town has an interesting history. It was named for Henry "Old Hundred" Church, a centenarian resident and former Redcoat, who with his wife Hannah became something of attractions on the B&O line as the "oldest couple in the states".

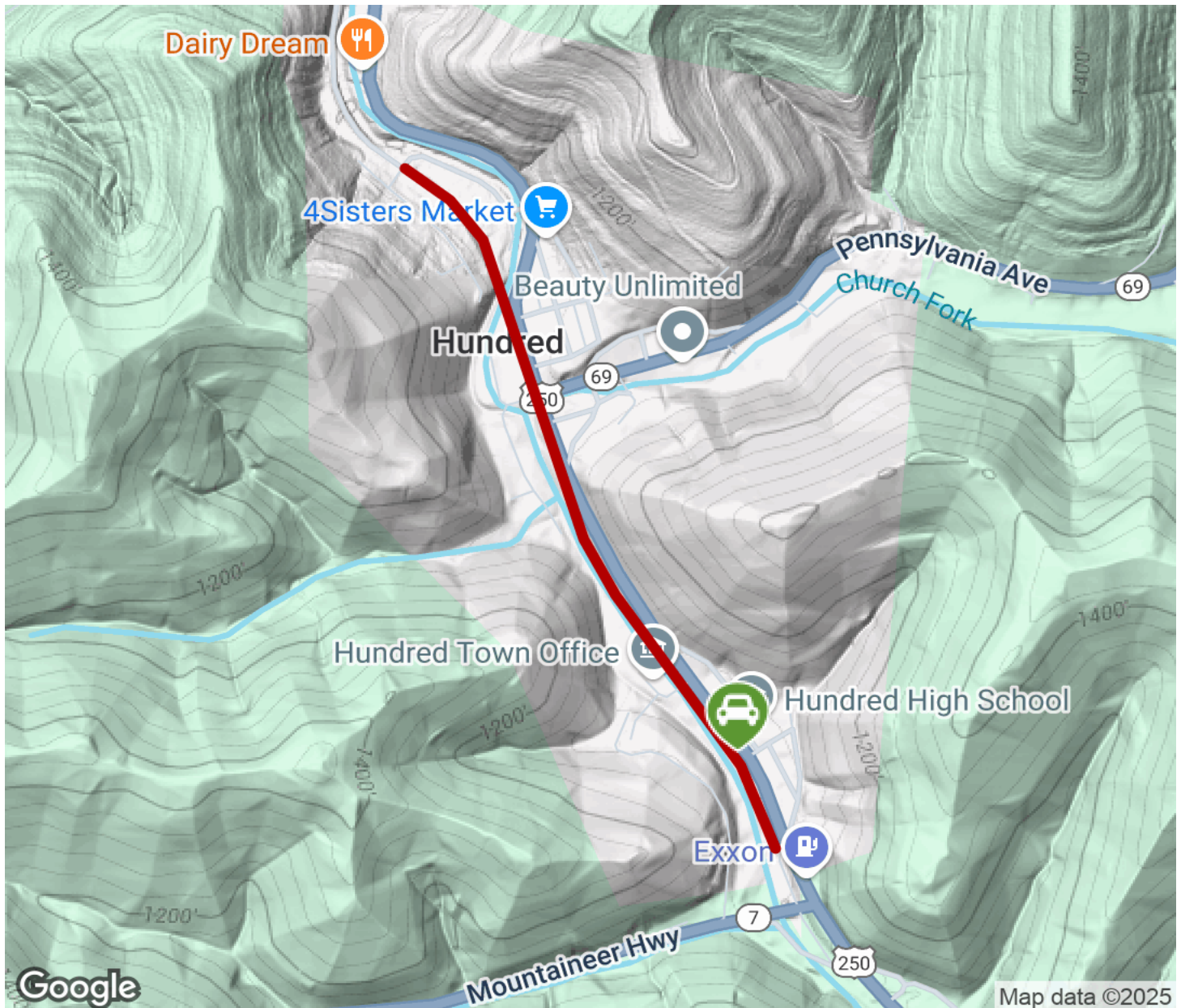
Parking & Trail Access
