The paved hiking and biking pathway connects to the [Depot Avenue Rail Trail](#) at its southern end, and terminates at the north end at NW 16th Avenue. The trail is planned to eventually extend further north to NW 39th Avenue.

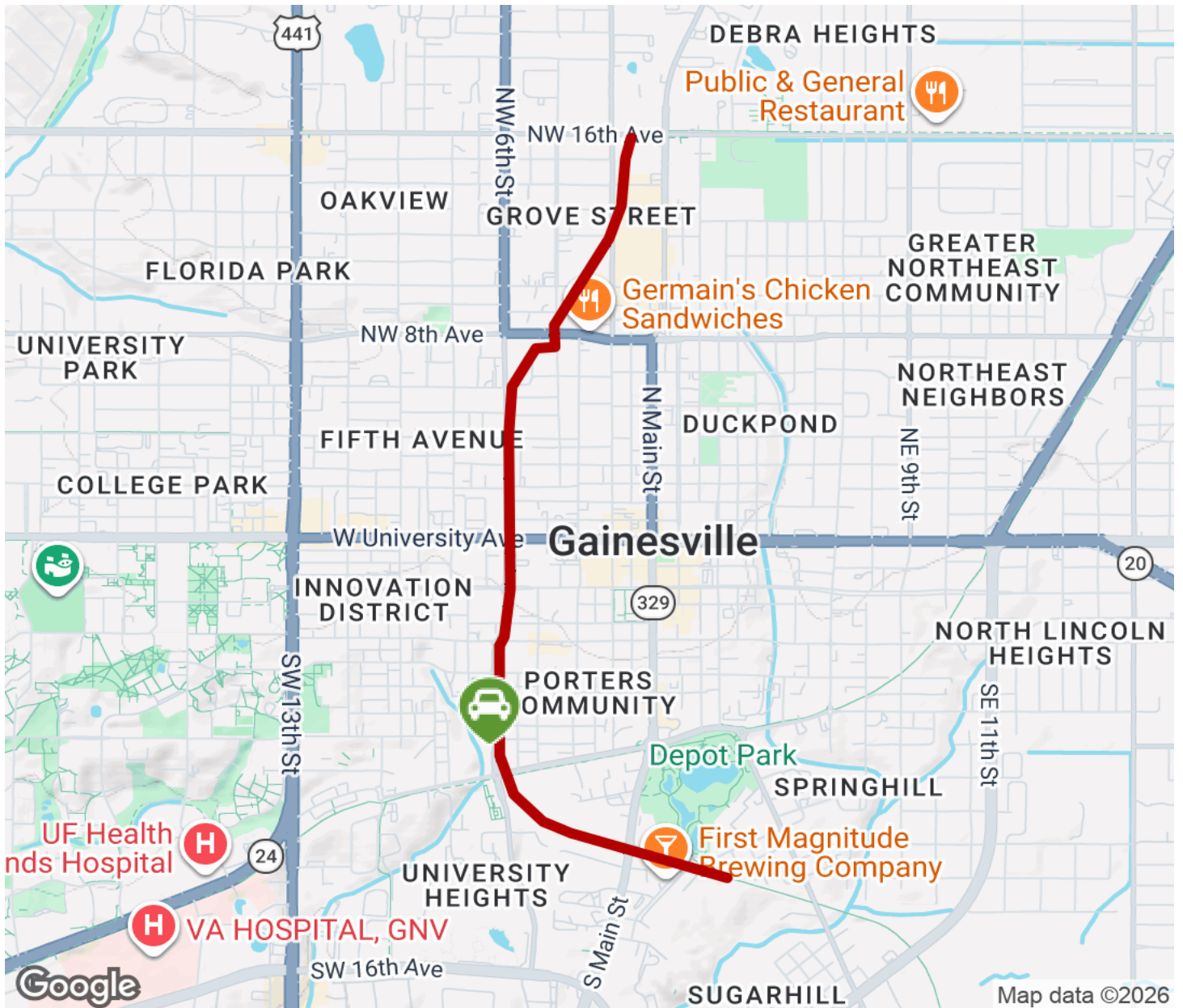
## Parking & Trail Access
