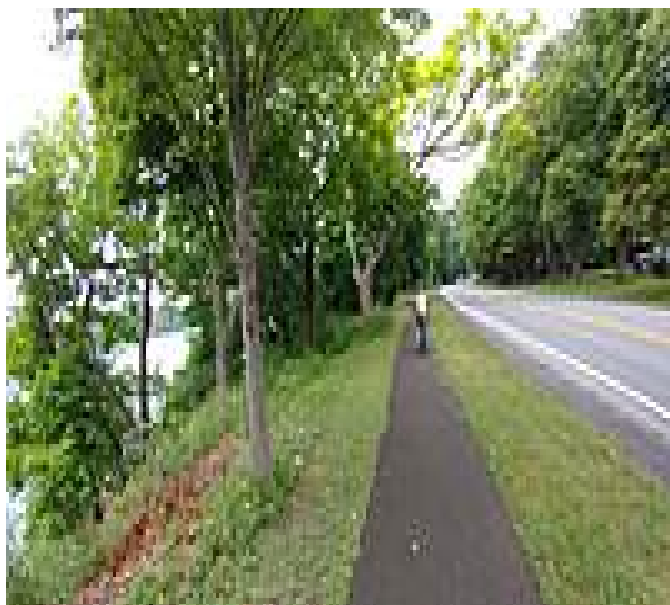

About the Route

Leaving from the southern end of the route, the Kiwanis Park Trail heads north to the Village of Lewiston off Mohawk Street just North of Center Street. Park at Kiwanis Park in the Village. The trail follows the Niagara Scenic Parkway to Fletcher Road for approximately 3 miles and then passes through Joseph Davis State Park.

The Kiwanis Park Trail is black top until reaching Youngstown, then the trail is concrete sidewalk through the village. From here, the trail heads all the way north until reaching Fort Niagara State Park.

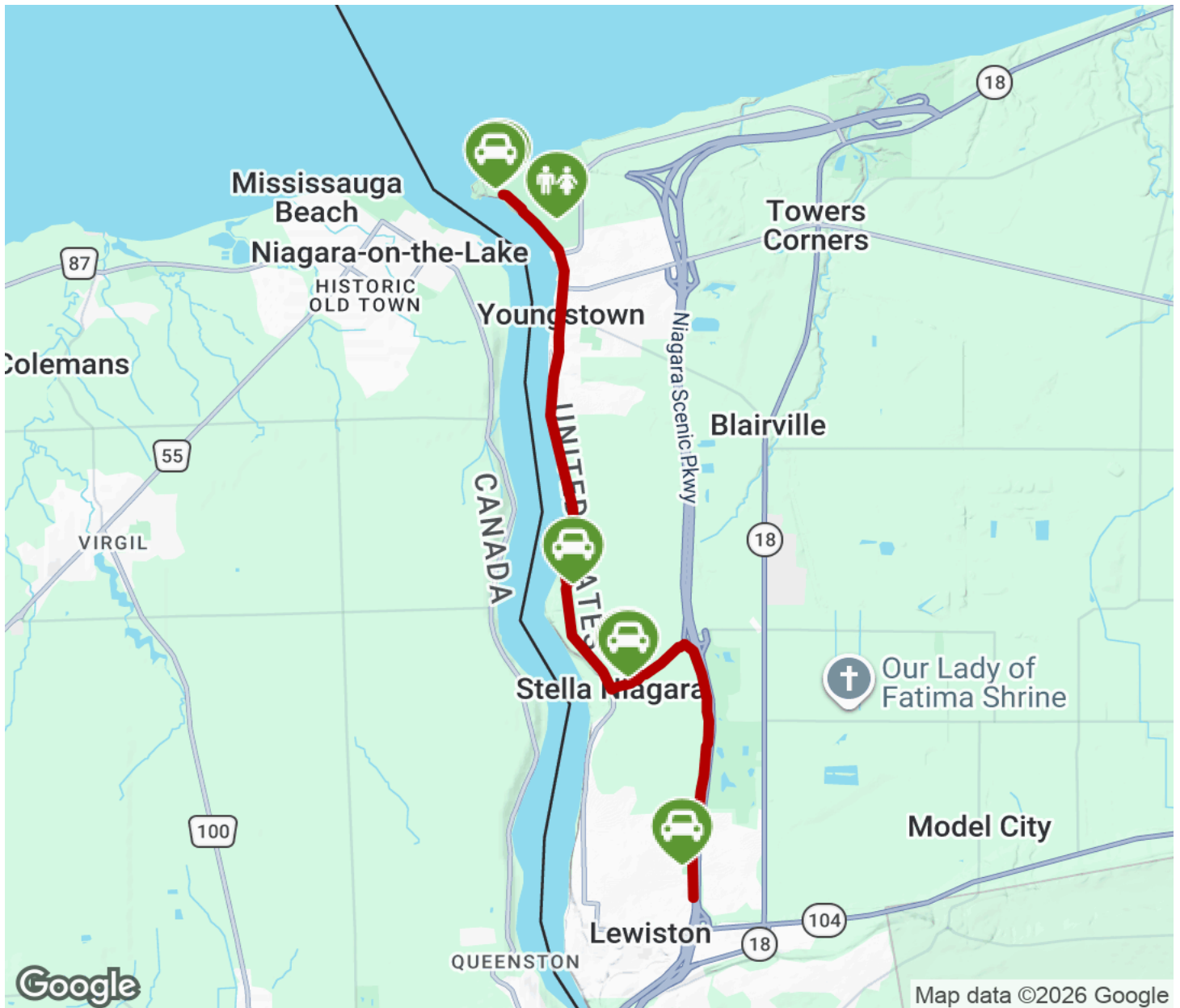
