Indiana

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Although its current length is just over a mile, the small-but-mighty Chessie Trail will connect several parks in the northwestern Indiana city of La Porte. At its northern end, the paved pathway offers access to Kiwanis-Teledyne Park and Unity Park on the banks of Pine Lake and, on its way south to Newport Landing, skirts Fox Memorial Park. Future plans call for the trail to also encircle Clear Lake.

The trail occupies the former right of way of the Chesapeake and Ohio (or Chessie) Railroad.

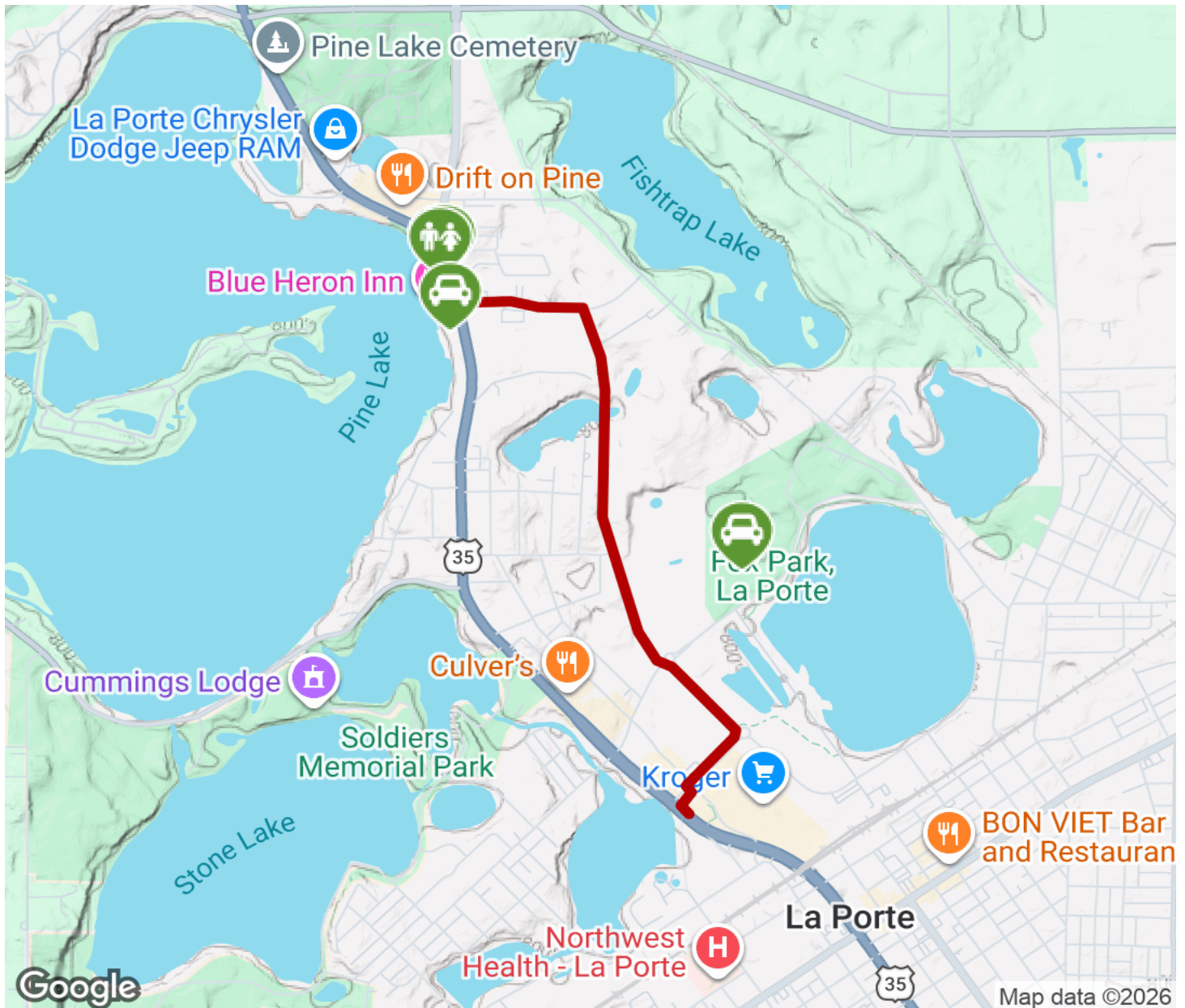
Parking & Trail Access
