The trail is the connector between two other popular trails, <u>Jordan Creek Trail</u> and the <u>Walnut</u> <u>Creek Trail</u>. It's 1.2 miles long and tree lined on one side as it winds through grassy open spaces. Once it crosses Walnut Creek along N. Valley Drive before connecting to the Walnut Creek Trail.


Parking & Trail Access
