Ridge Run Trail, in the northern Indiana town of Middlebury, offers helpful connections in the community. On its southern end, the



Ridge Run Trail, in the northern Indiana town of Middlebury, offers helpful connections in the community. On its southern end, the paved pathway connects with the beloved [Pumpkinvine Nature Trail](#), which heads east to Shipshewana and southwest to Goshen.

From the Pumpkinvine trail intersection (near the U.S. 20 tunnel), the Ridge Run travels north to its end at Wayne Avenue, where it connects to another [trail](#) which parallels the street. The two trails meet near the Middlebury Community Schools campus and the Das Dutchman Essenhaus complex, which includes an Amish-style restaurant, inn, and boutique shops.


Parking & Trail Access
