On its west end, it provides residents with access to the Das Dutchman Essenhaus complex, a popular Amishthemed attraction. Here, travelers can also connect to the <u>Ridge Run Trail</u> to head south.

Another trail connection is possible on its east end, where the Wayne Avenue Trail meets the 17-mile <u>Pumpkinvine</u> <u>Nature Trail</u>.
