The Wayne Avenue Trail serves as a pleasant east-west connector through the quiet, tree-filled neighborhoods of Middlebury in northern Indiana.

On its west end, it provides residents with access to the Das Dutchman Essenhaus complex, a popular Amish-themed attraction. Here, travelers can also connect to the [Ridge Run Trail](#) to head south.

Another trail connection is possible on its east end, where the Wayne Avenue Trail meets the 17-mile [Pumpkinvine Nature Trail](#).

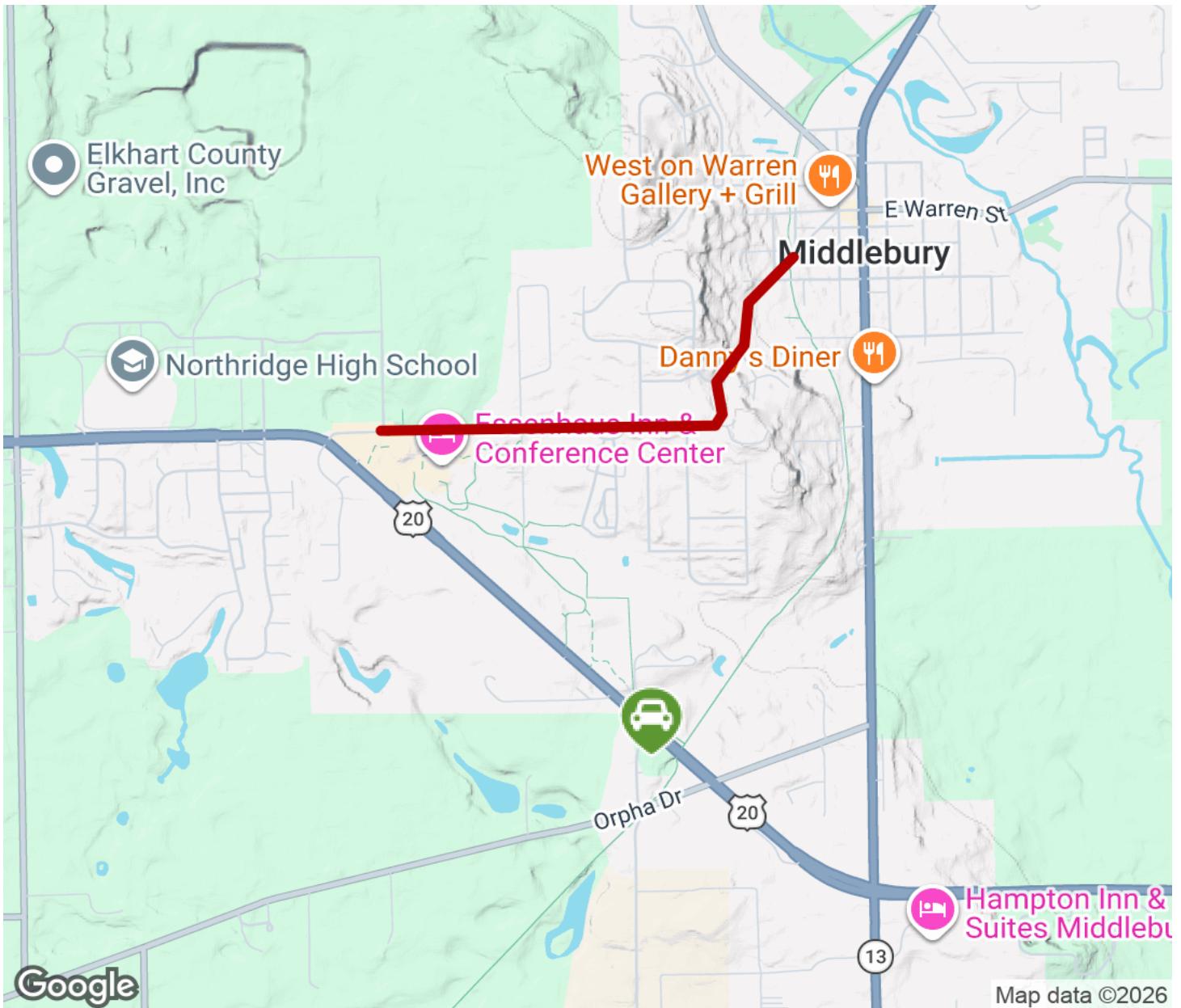
Parking & Trail Access
