The Weisgarber Greenway basically mirrors the alignment of the road by the same name for about a mile, beginning the intersection



The Weisgarber Greenway basically mirrors the alignment of the road by the same name for about a mile, beginning the intersection of old Weisberger Rd. and Papermill Rd. north to Middlebrook Pike (SR 169). Fourth Creek flows along the west side of the greenway. Future plans will connect the Weisgarber and Papermill Bluff greenways to the Lakeshore Greenway, the most heavily used trail in the city.

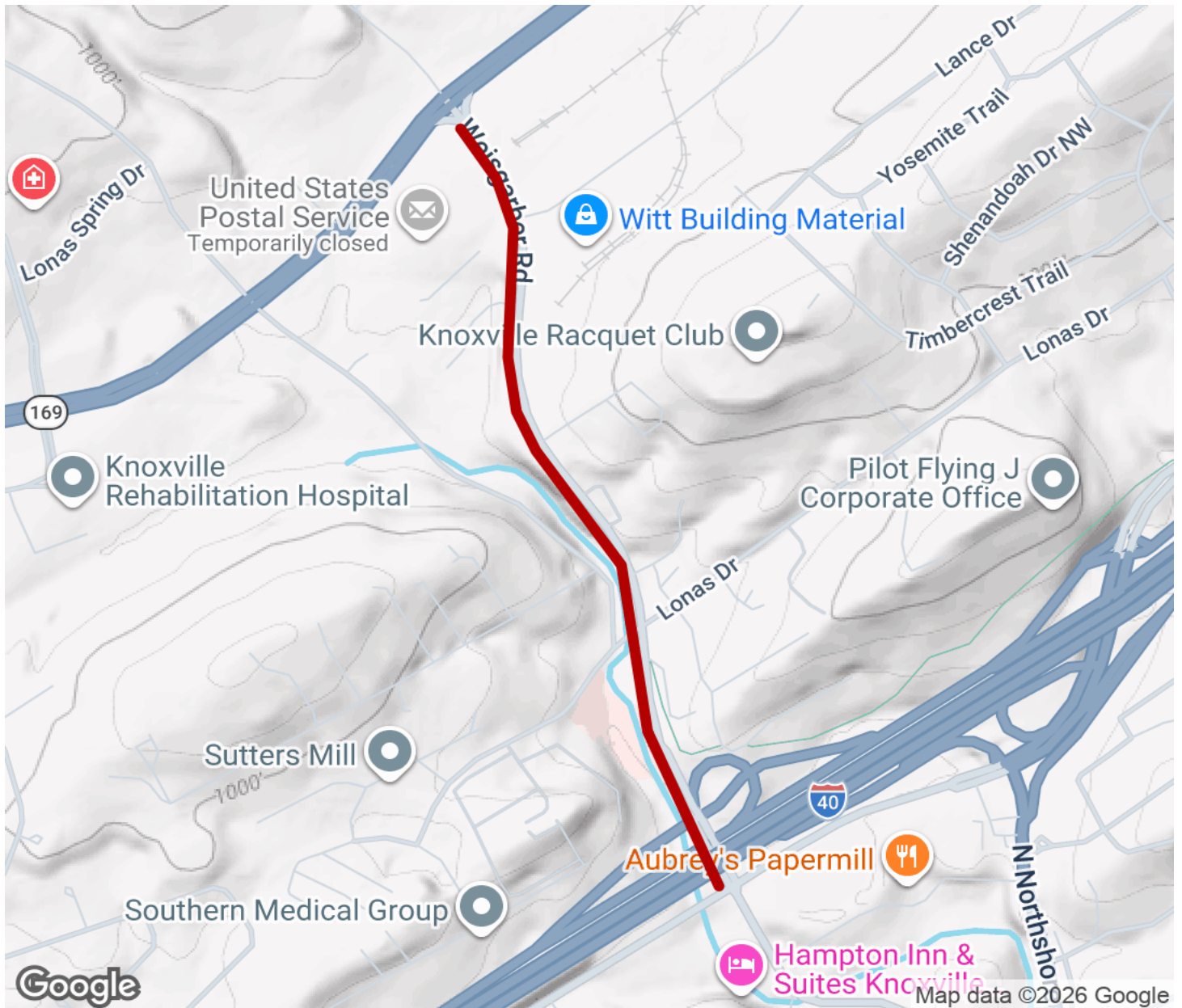
Parking & Trail Access
