

Lincolnwood Valley Line Trail Illinois



The Lincolnwood Valley Line Trail connects the existing Valley Line Trail (Sauganash Trail) to the Skokie Valley Trail in Cook County.



The Lincolnwood Valley Line Trail connects the existing Valley Line Trail (Sauganash Trail) to the Skokie Valley Trail in Cook County. Like the previous segments, this trail occupies a former Union Pacific railroad right-of-way. There are a couple of road crossings, but a pedestrian overpass is under construction over Touhy Avenue.

With the construction of the Lincolnville Valley Line Trail, the Skokie Valley to Sauganash corridor provides 4.5-mile unbroken bike-ped corridor.
