The Third Creek Greenway is a paved pedestrian and bike path in West Knoxville that mostly lies within a wooded riparian corridor.



The Third Creek Greenway is a paved pedestrian and bike path in West Knoxville that mostly lies within a wooded riparian corridor. The trail happens to connect to three other trails: [Bearden Village Greenway](#) to the east, [Sequoyah Greenway](#) to the south and [Neyland Greenway](#) to the southwest.

From the park of the same name, the Third Creek Greenway runs east, across S. Concord St. then bends, curving around the perimeter of Tyson Park. There is a crossing underneath Alcoa Highway and then the path snakes through the University of Tennessee Gardens. Another underpass takes you under Joe Johnson Dr. to Neyland Dr. where the trail's terminus is found.

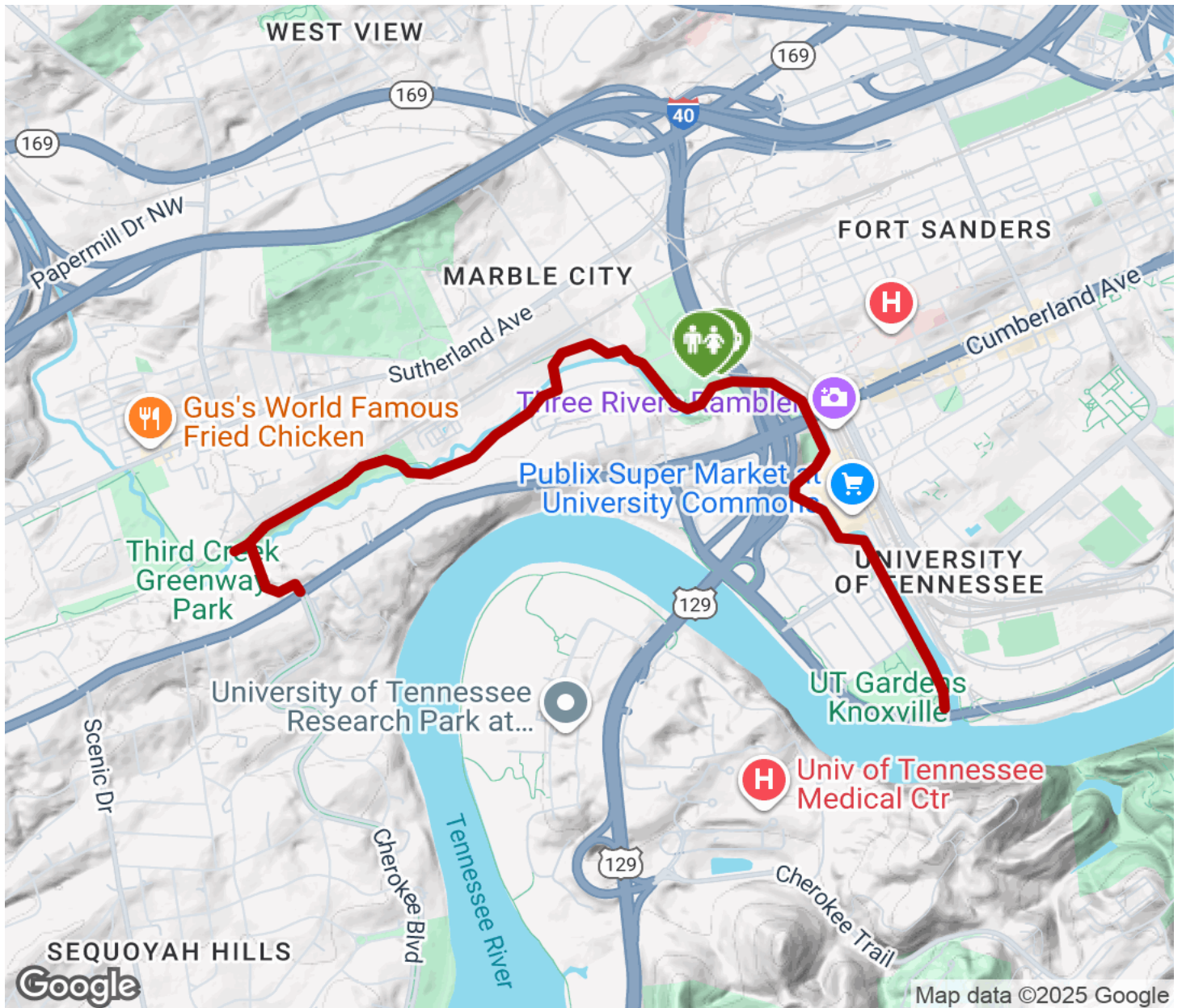
Parking & Trail Access
