From Third Creek Greenway Park, the Bearden Village Greenway extends west along Sutherland Ave., terminating a little after Westward Ave. Though short, the trail does have some significant connections: it acts as a safe route for kids to get to West High School and Bearden Elementary Center. It also links at its eastern end to the Third Creek Greenway, and the larger Knoxville greenway system. Historic markers along the greenway help narrate the history of Bearden Village.

Turn right at Sutherland Ave. and then left at the first light (Forest Hills Blvd into the shopping center parking area. The Bearden Village Greenway is north of here, along Sutherland Rd.
