The Jordan Creek Greenway is a paved 3-mile multiuse trail in downtown Springfield, Missouri. The trail exists in 3



The Jordan Creek Greenway is a paved 3-mile multiuse trail in downtown Springfield, Missouri.

The trail exists in 3 disconnected segments: The most northerly section runs for about a mile from Smith Park, through residential areas and Silver Springs Park to Sherman Avenue near Ozark Technical Community College. The second segment begins at Jordan Valley Park west to N Jefferson Avenue. The final mile is further south, stretching from Cruse Dog Park to Wilson's Creek Greenway.

Future planned extensions will connect the three segments through West Meadows Park.

Parking & Trail Access

Parking is available at any of the parks along any of the trail segments. From north to south, Smith Park, located at 1500 E. Division St.; Silver Springs Park located at 1099 E Webster St.; Jordan Valley Park at 635 E Trafficway; Cruse Dog Park at 2100 W Catalpa St; and Ewing Park Sports Complex at 1400 Scenic Ave.

Parking can also be found in downtown Springfield.



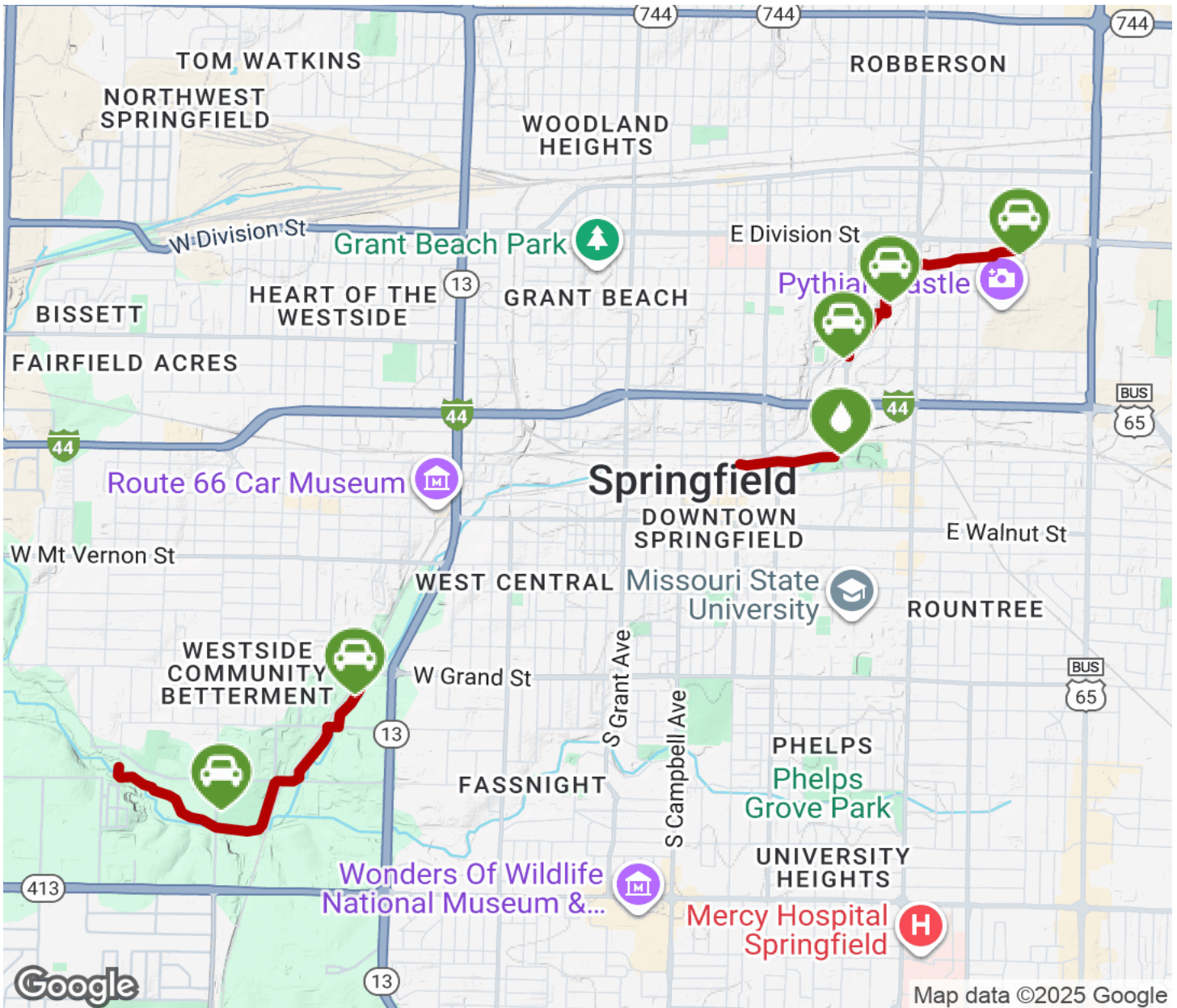
