Casselberry Greenway **Trail**

Florida



Casselberry Greenway Trail (formerly known as Wirz Trail) is a 5-mile multi-use path zig-zagging through Casselberry, Florida,



1.5-mile section leaves off in the east from Laurel Way to S Winter Drive, connecting to Casselberry Elementary and South Seminole Middle School. Crossing S Winter Drive is the final mile of the greenway, a neighborhood trail that passes through a wooded area and comes to its western end at S Triplet Drive.

Casselberry Greenway Trail (formerly known as Wirz Trail) is a 5-mile multi-use path zig-zagging through Casselberry, Florida, linking neighborhoods to schools, parks and shopping.

About the Route

The southern segment leaves off in the west from Kewannee Trail on Wilshire Boulevard. The trail travels east through mostly residential areas, across SR 436 (Semoran Blvd), through Cannon Way and S Winter Park Drive into Wirz Park, where the trail loops around the copse of trees in the center of the park.

The second segment is about 0.9 miles north of the first, and the two are connected via on-street bike lanes. This
