

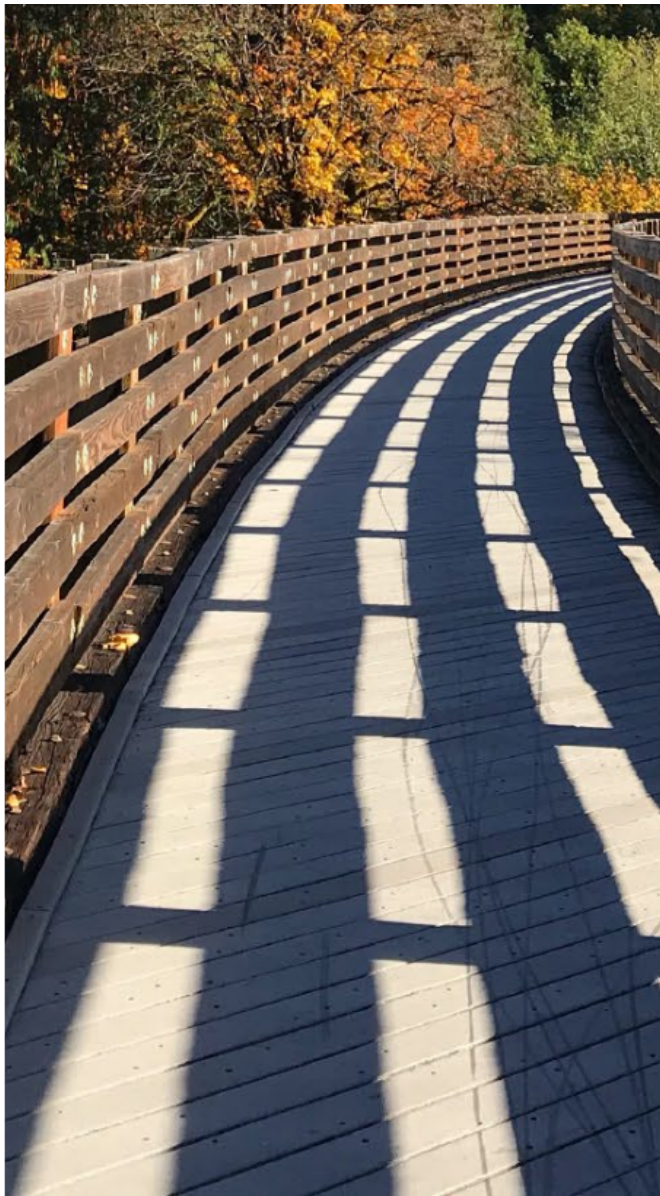

PV Pipeline Trail

Arizona

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The asphalt and concrete trail begins at Lakeshore Drive and Navajo Drive, and travels north to Powers Avenue. It occupies the right-of-way of the Kinder Morgan company's pipeline through Prescott Valley. It connects commercial areas to neighborhoods and green spaces, but it also links up with other multi-use paths (Central Core and Powers Ave. multi-use paths specifically) as part of Prescott Valley's Bicycle Master Plan. While the trail is rather steep in areas, the city has also provided ADA accessible ramps.

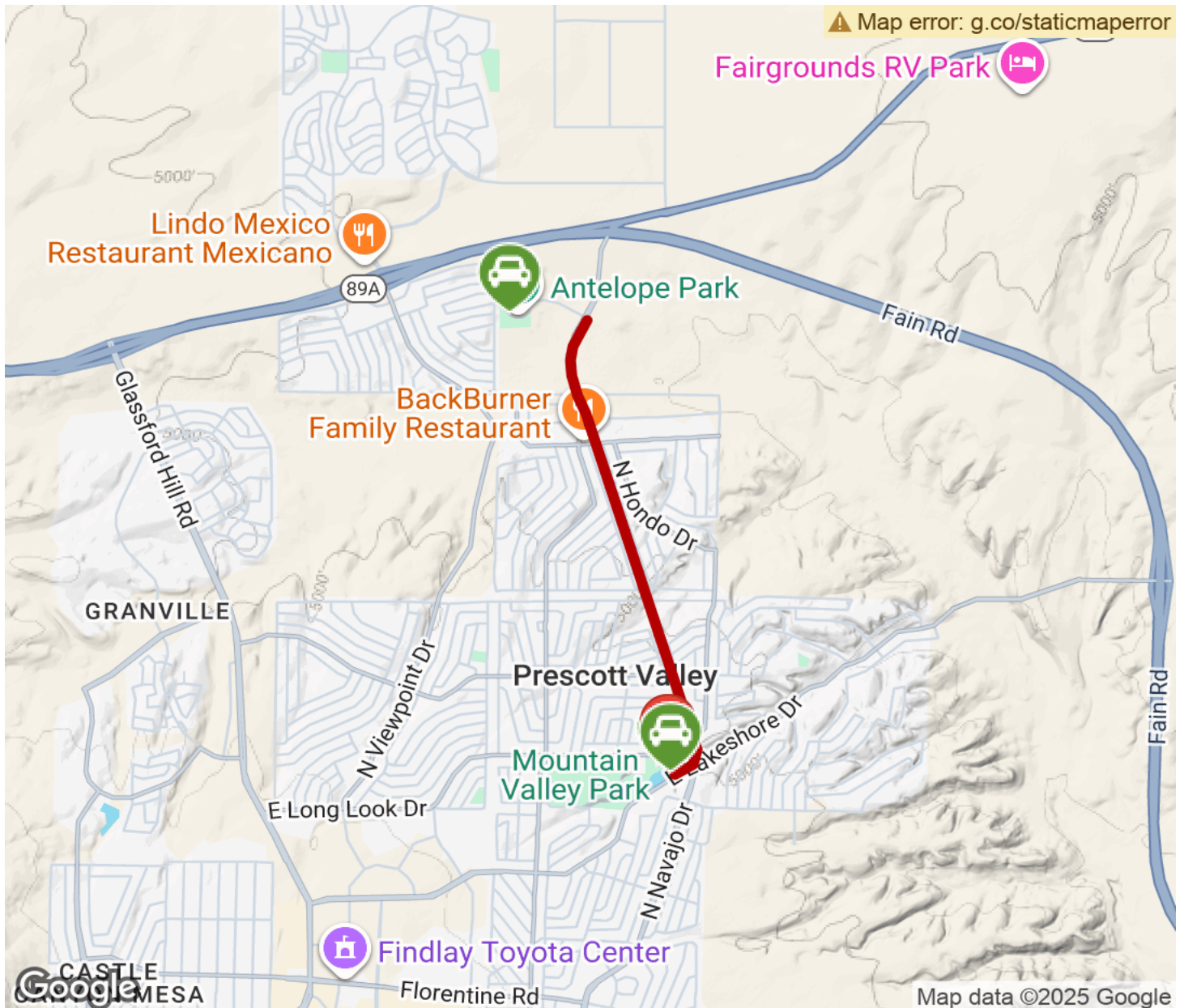
