Pine Hills Trail

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Opened in 2017, Orange County's Pine Hills Trail spans 1.75 miles from Alhambra Drive to Silver Star Road in a western subdivision of Orlando. In the middle of the north-south route, a spur heads southeast for an additional 0.75 miles to Barnett Park, which offers numerous recreational amenities. Running through a utility corridor, the paved pathway traverses residential neighborhoods.

Future northward extensions of the trail will connect it to the [Seminole-Wekiva Trail](#), while a southward expansion will one day connect it to the [Shingle Creek Regional Trail](#).

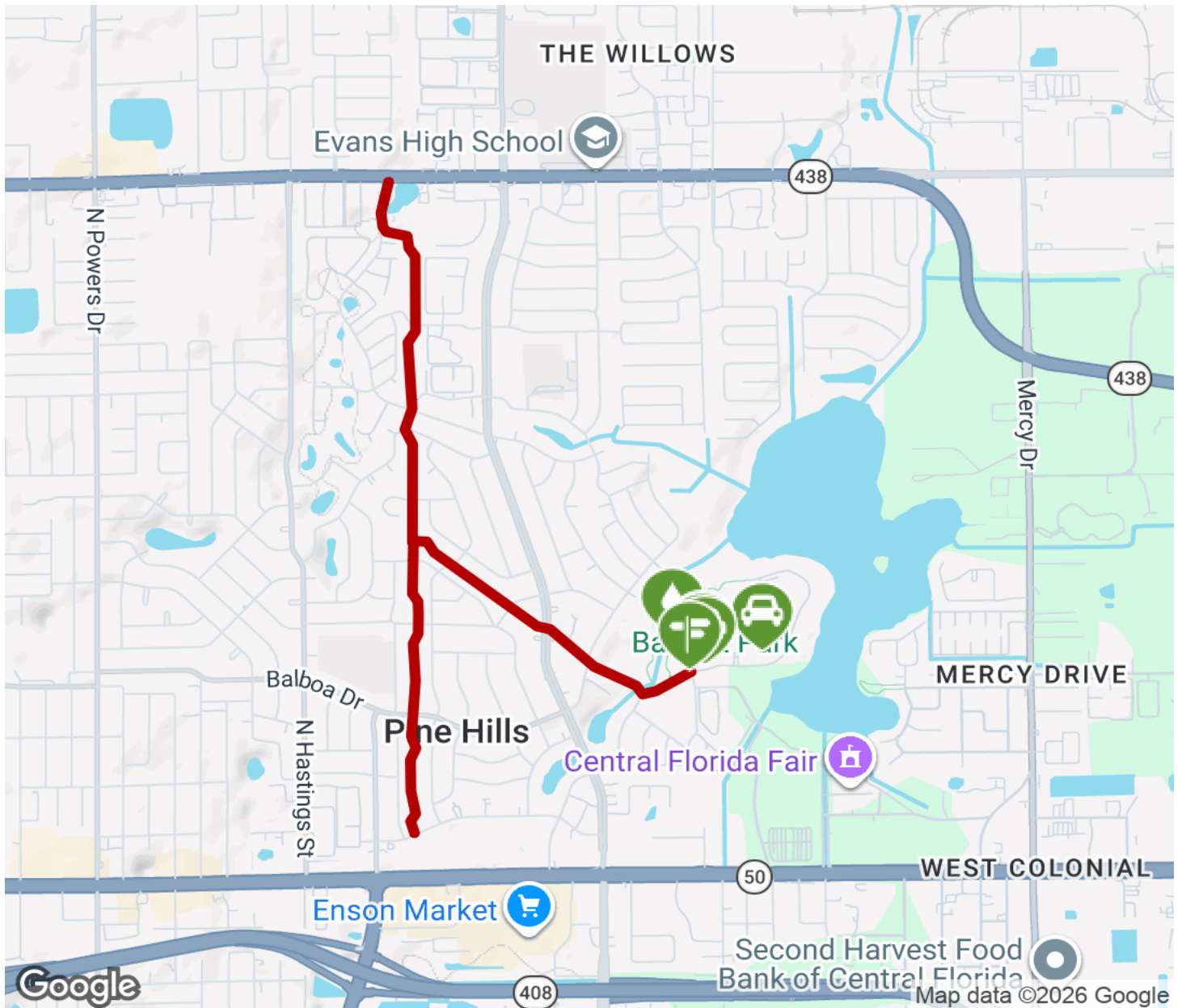
