Glens Creek Greenway is a one-mile shared use trail in Asheville, North Carolina. It stretches between Weaver Park and Broadway



Glens Creek Greenway is a one-mile shared use trail in Asheville, North Carolina. It stretches between Weaver Park and Broadway St. Although short, the trail connects to destinations including Weaver Park, Botanical Gardens, schools and a USDA Research Station.

The trail is part of Asheville's growing greenways network. The city is working to create a welcoming environment for walkers, cyclists, joggers, folks walking dogs and many other kinds of active recreation. Other greenways to enjoy include French Broad River Greenway, Riverbend Park Greenway. Reed Creek Greenway picks up where Glens Creek ends at Broadway St.

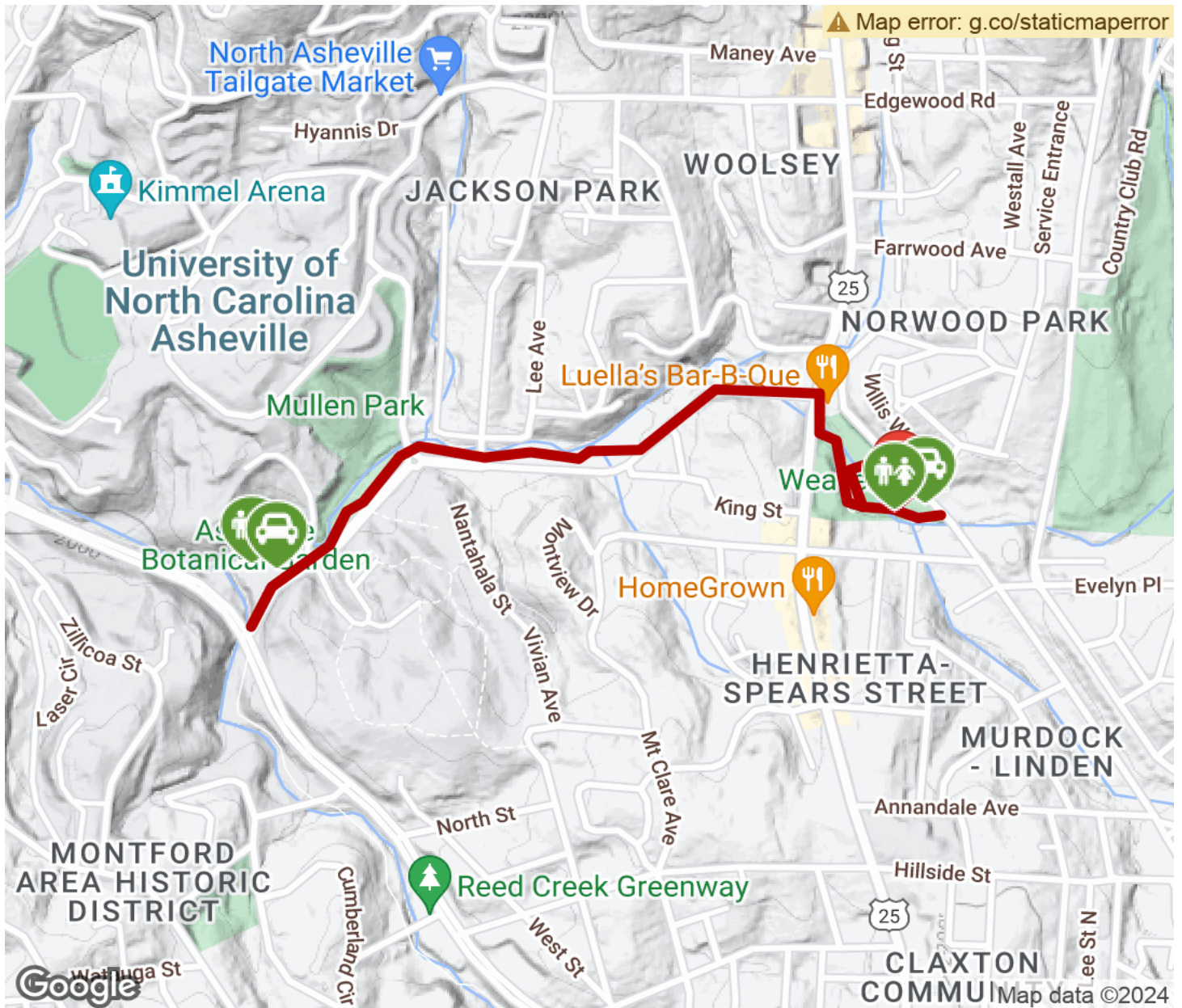
Parking & Trail Access
