Glens Creek Greenway is a one-mile shared use trail in Asheville, North Carolina. It stretches between Weaver Park and Broadway St. Although short, the trail connects to destinations including Weaver Park, Botanical Gardens, schools and a USDA Research Station.

The trail is part of Asheville's growing greenways network. The city is working to create a welcoming environment for walkers, cyclists, joggers, folks walking dogs and many other kinds of active recreation. Other greenways to enjoy include French Broad River

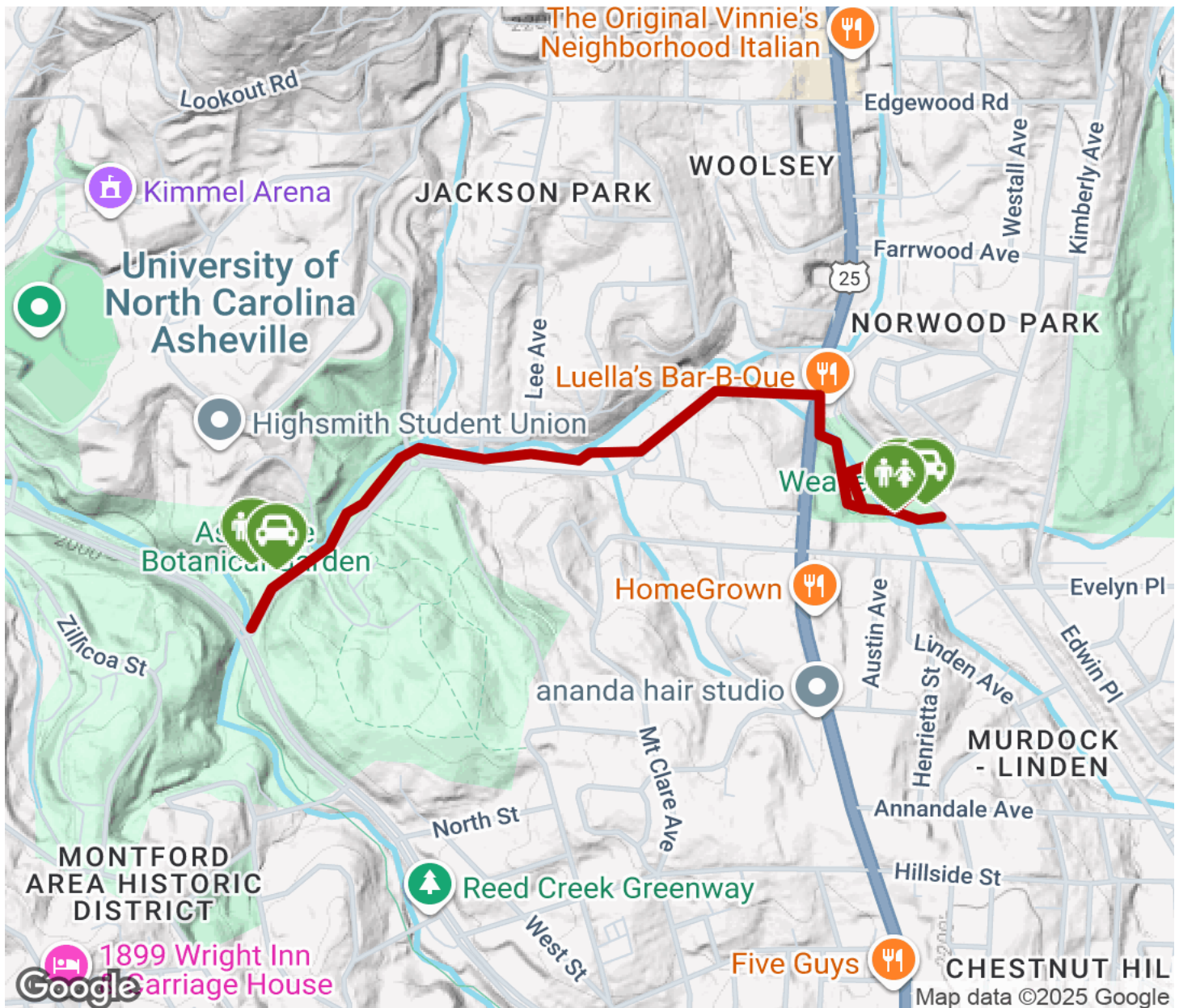
