

The Big 4 Trail will eventually connect all of Boone County, from the Marion County line to the south, to the Clinton County line to the



through tree canopies, farmland, and the historic downtown.

The Big 4 Trail will eventually connect all of Boone County, from the Marion County line to the south, to the Clinton County line to the north. A large portion of the rail-trail is already complete. Whitestown's portion is completely paved, including a new trailhead and plenty of parking at 104 South Main St in Whitestown.

At its southeast end, the Whitestown's portion of the Big 4 Trail connects with the northwest end of the Zionsville's section. The northwest end of the Whitestown segment will eventually connect to the Lebanon to Colfax section.

The trail highlights the historic railroad route upon which both the Lincoln Inaugural Train and the Lincoln Funeral Train traveled in 1861 and 1865, respectively. Walkers, runners and bikers can enjoy the paved trail winding
