MLK Drive Trail Pennsylvania



Philadelphia's MLK Drive Trail offers a paved 4-mile route along Martin Luther King Jr. Drive that's popular for both transportation



Philadelphia's MLK Drive Trail offers a paved 4-mile route along Martin Luther King Jr. Drive that's popular for both transportation and recreation. The trail begins near the Philadelphia Art Museum and soon crosses the <u>Schuylkill</u> <u>River Trail</u>. From there, the MLK Drive Trail heads across the Schuylkill River and follows its tree-lined western bank.

Winding northward, the trail ends at the historical Falls Bridge, a 556-foot expanse dating back to 1895. Trail users can cross the bridge to meet up with the Schuylkill River Trail again and head south back to the art museum. This forms a pleasant trail loop of about 8 miles roundtrip.

On weekends from April through October, bicyclists can also safely use the paralleling roadway (Martin Luther



King Jr. Drive) as it's closed to motorists during that period.


Parking & Trail Access
