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Coombs Creek Trail is a multiuse hard surface trail matching along Kessler Parkway between Stevens Park Golf Course and Kessler Parkway Park. The 2.5 -mile hike and bike path provides access to the Trinity River levee, as well as the Oak Cliff neighborhood. It will eventually link up with the [Trinity Skyline Trail](#). Interesting tidbit: there are rumors the trail is "[haunted](#)".

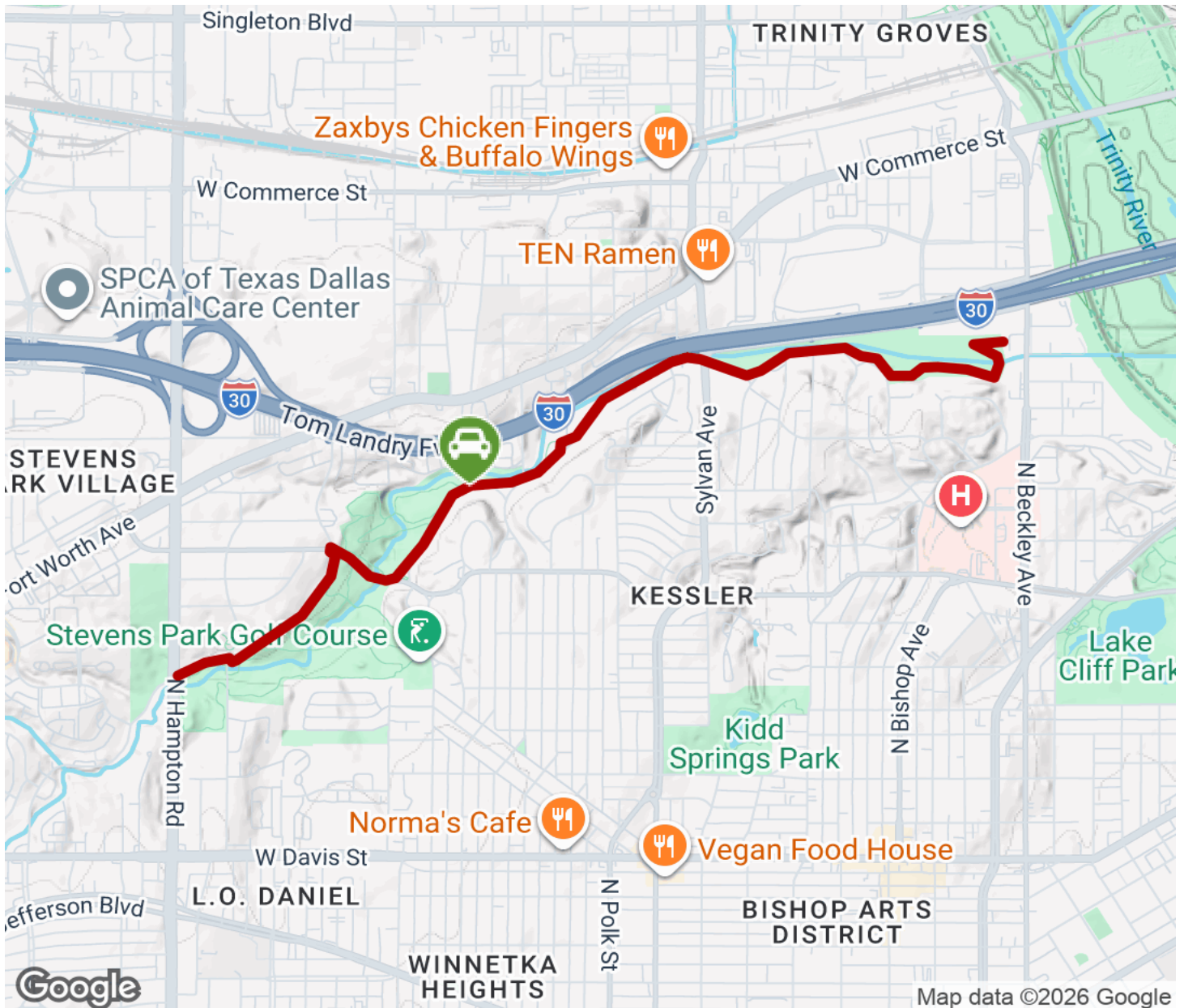
