The Austin to Manor Trail provides a convenient trail connection to nearby Austin-Area trails. The trail is a 5.6 rail-with-trail and is



At the southern end of the trail, the Austin to Manor Trail connects to the [Southern Walnut Creek Trail](#).

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About the Route

The Austin to Manor Trail leaves off in the south from the intersection of the [Southern Walnut Creek Trail](#), then winds 2.5 miles through the northeastern outskirts of Austin. The paved pathway first parallels Daffan Lane through a rural area then turns to loosely follow Decker Lane as it skirts through a more tree-filled area along the shoreline of Walter E. Long Lake. The northern part of the trail is a rail-with-trail and follows an active rail line.

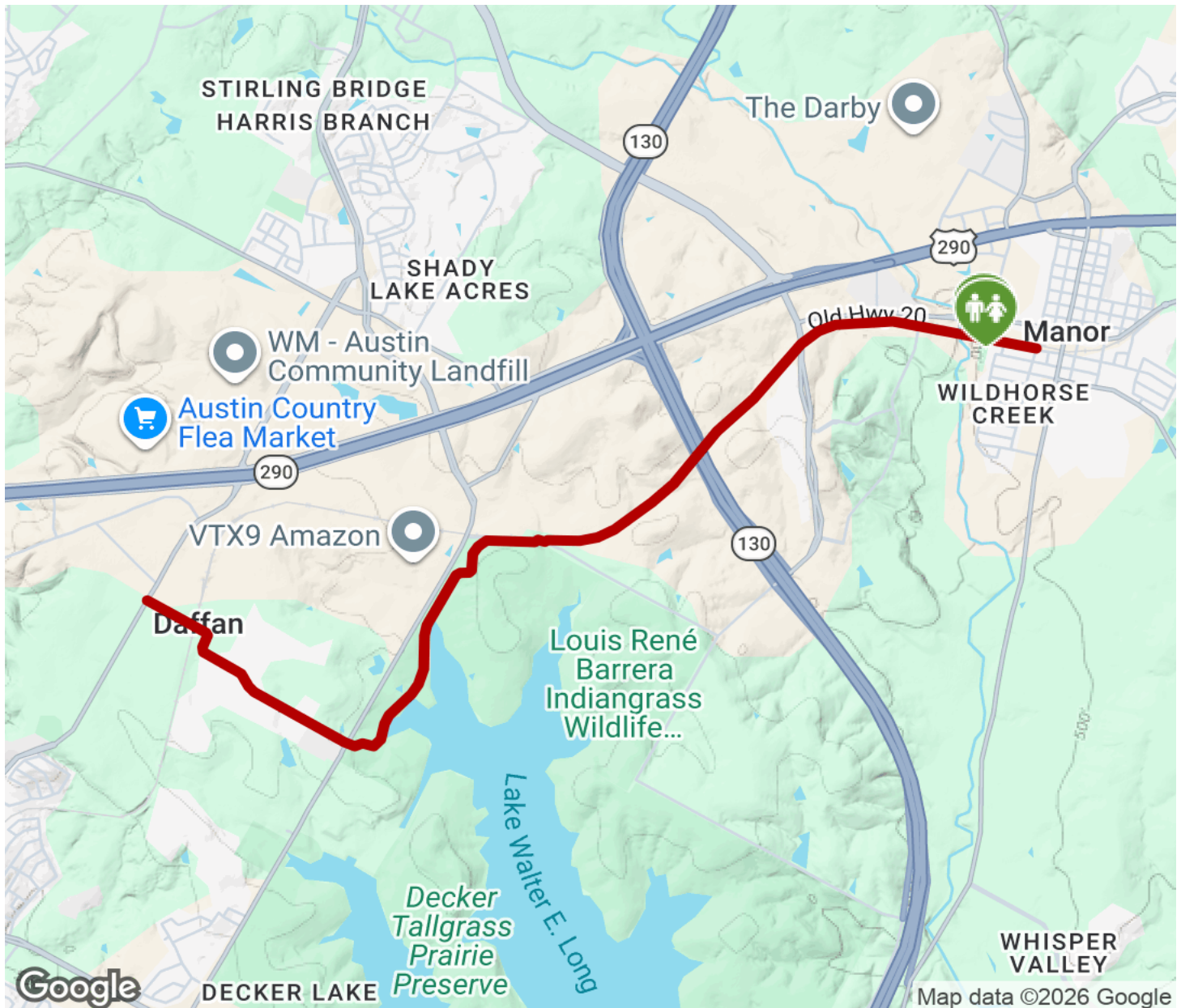
