The Stadium Connector Shared Use Pathway is a short but important route in northwestern Mesa, Arizona. It links Hohokam



The Stadium Connector Shared Use Pathway is a short but important route in northwestern Mesa, Arizona. It links Hohokam Stadium (the spring training home of the Oakland Athletics) and Sloan Park (the training home of the Chicago Cubs) with the [Rio Salado Pathway](#) and Tempe Town Lake in the neighboring City of Tempe. For longer trips, trail users can also hop on the nearby [Tempe Canal Path](#), a paved 6-mile pathway, at N. Alma School Road.

Although much of the Stadium Connector route is off-road trail, note that a portion is cycle track.

Parking and restrooms are available in nearby Riverview Park (2100 W. Rio Salado Parkway, Mesa), which is just a couple blocks west of the Stadium Connector's western endpoint.



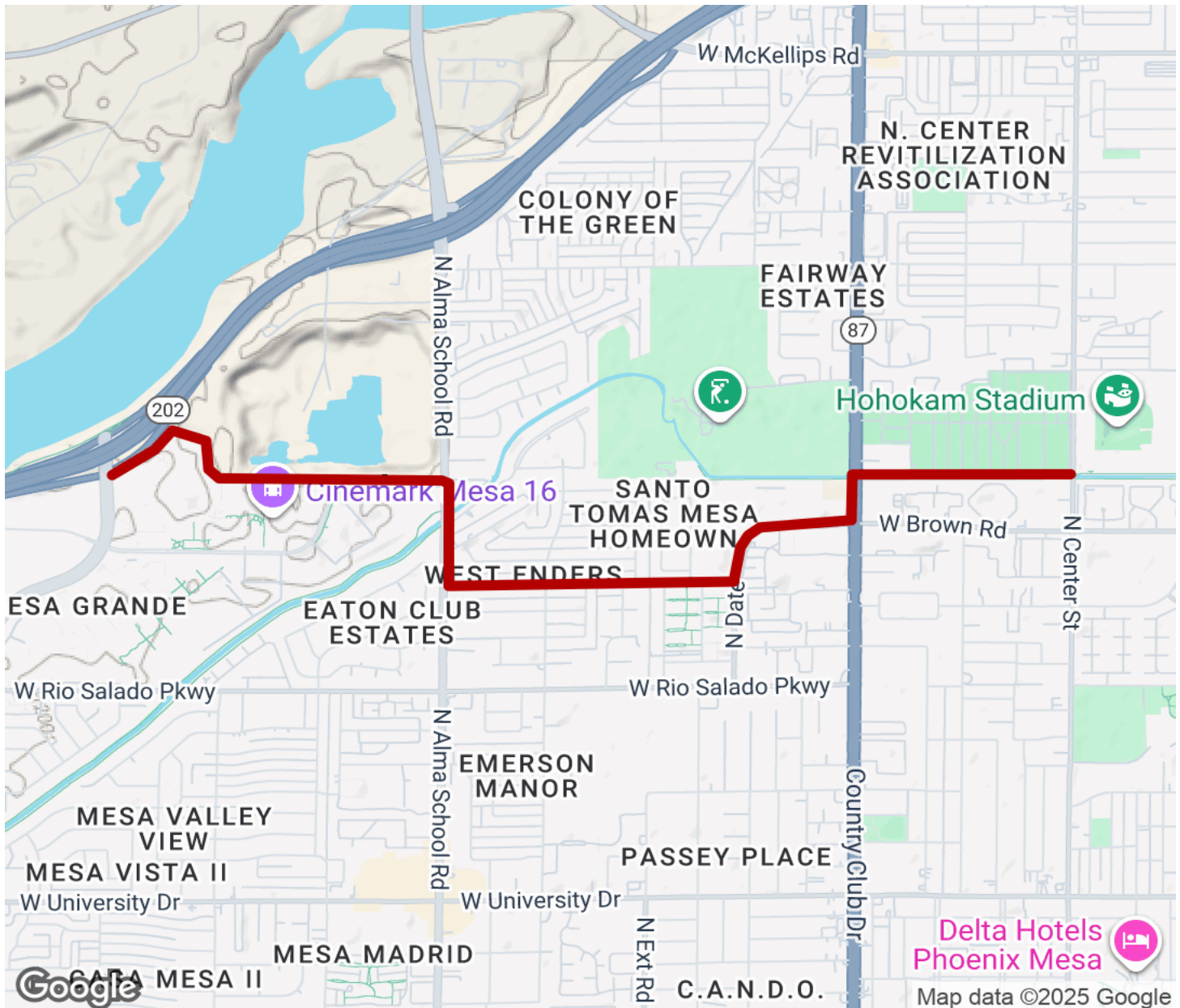
