This is a U-shaped multiple use pathway in Grand Prairie, Dallas County. Beginning at the Grand Prairie Tourist Information Center in Lone Star Park, the trail then travels south parallel to N Beltline Road. Continuing left and east along Trinity River, and after a right turn onto Hunter Ferrell Road, the trail inks up with the City of Irving's Campion Trail.
