Continuing left and east along Trinity River, and after a right turn onto Hunter Ferrell Road, the trail inks up with the City of Irving's [Campion Trail](#).

Park at Lone Star Park (1000 Lone Star Pkwy); its sprawling campus features a concert venue, racing track and even a minor league baseball stadium.




