Located in Worcester Township, the Zacharias Creek Trail is a an easy walk or ride along water, through riparian woods and across green fields. The trail begins on Green Hill road (where there is a small parking area) and heads east along the trail up to Hollow Road, where it begins to wind southwards. There are a couple of on-street sections on Hollow Road, as well as a crosswalk where the trail starts heads in the direction of Heebner Park, it's other endpoint.

Note: In addition to walking and biking, equestrian use is allowed on designated portions of the trail. Contact the trail management for more details.

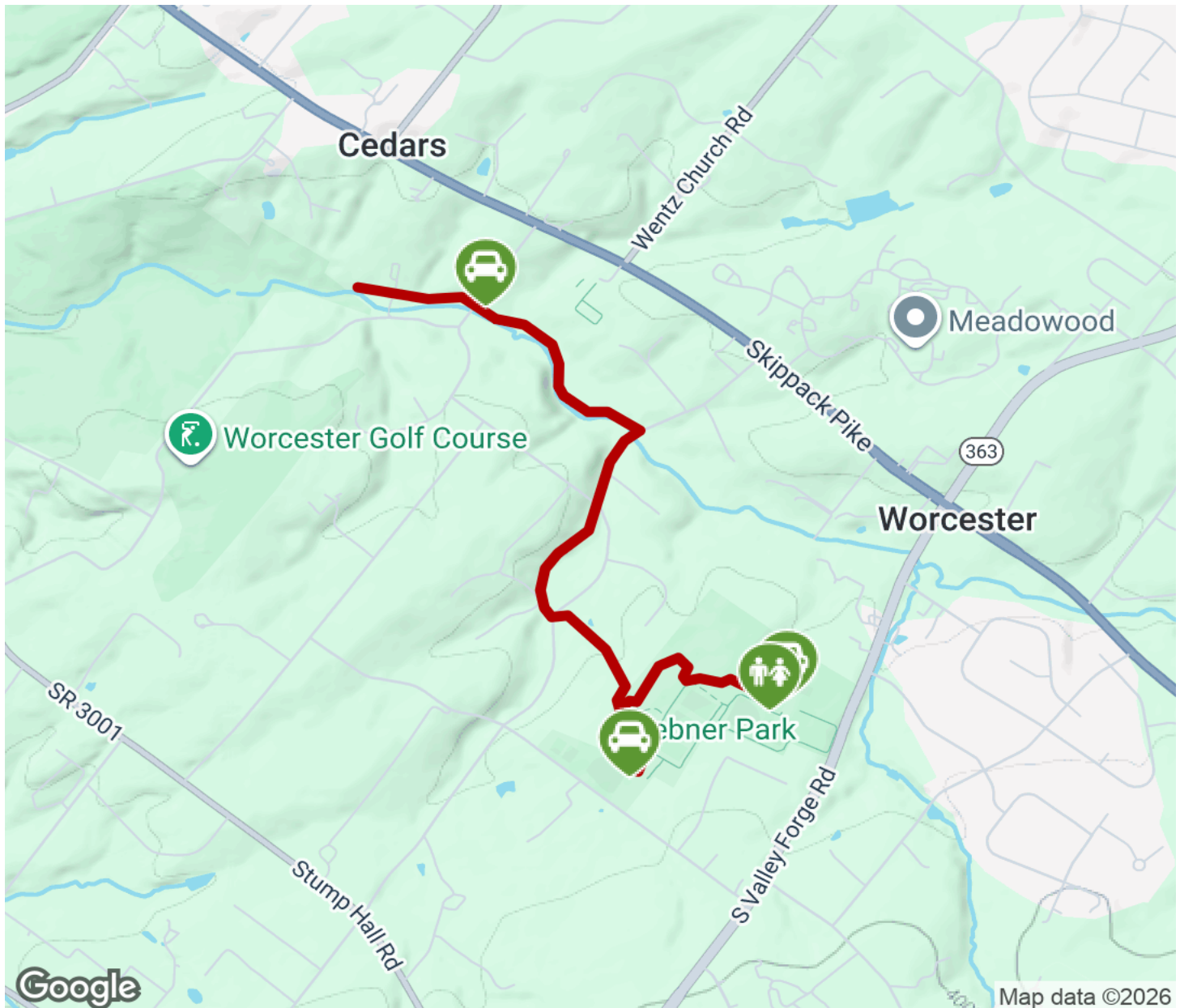
