But the mere fact that these facilities were not safely, comfortably accessible via biking and walking were hampering the full enjoyment of these facilities. The Poquessing Creek Trail meets this need, connecting residents of this neighborhood to nature. The hard surface trail begins at Junod Playground, going past a number of athletic amenities, with connections to the otherwise dead-ended suburban streets like Mechanicsville and McNulty Roads. It threads through Poquessing Valley Park north until it connects to Benjamin Rush State Park nature trails. While it's only 1.5 miles long, the trail goes a long way into improving access to the outdoors for residents. The trail is part of The

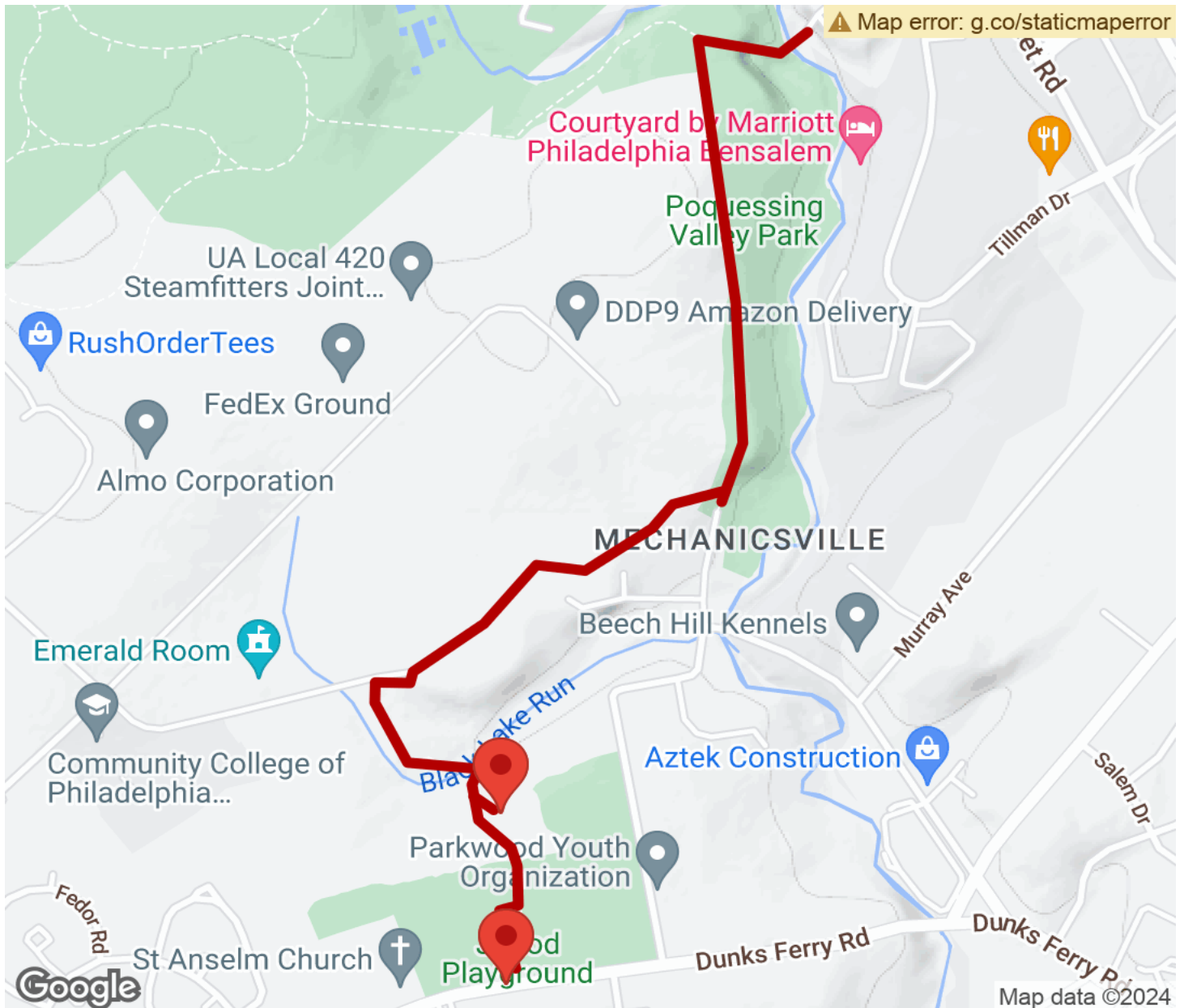
