With vistas of the Catskill Mountains and a vast blue lake, the Ashokan Reservoir Promenade is a paved pathway that spans just

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About the Route

The trail follows the edge of the reservoir between Olivebridge, a hamlet in southeastern New York, and the western outskirts of Kingston. Along the way, look for bald eagles or deer on the forested slopes that surround the trail. Dogs are not allowed on the Promenade.

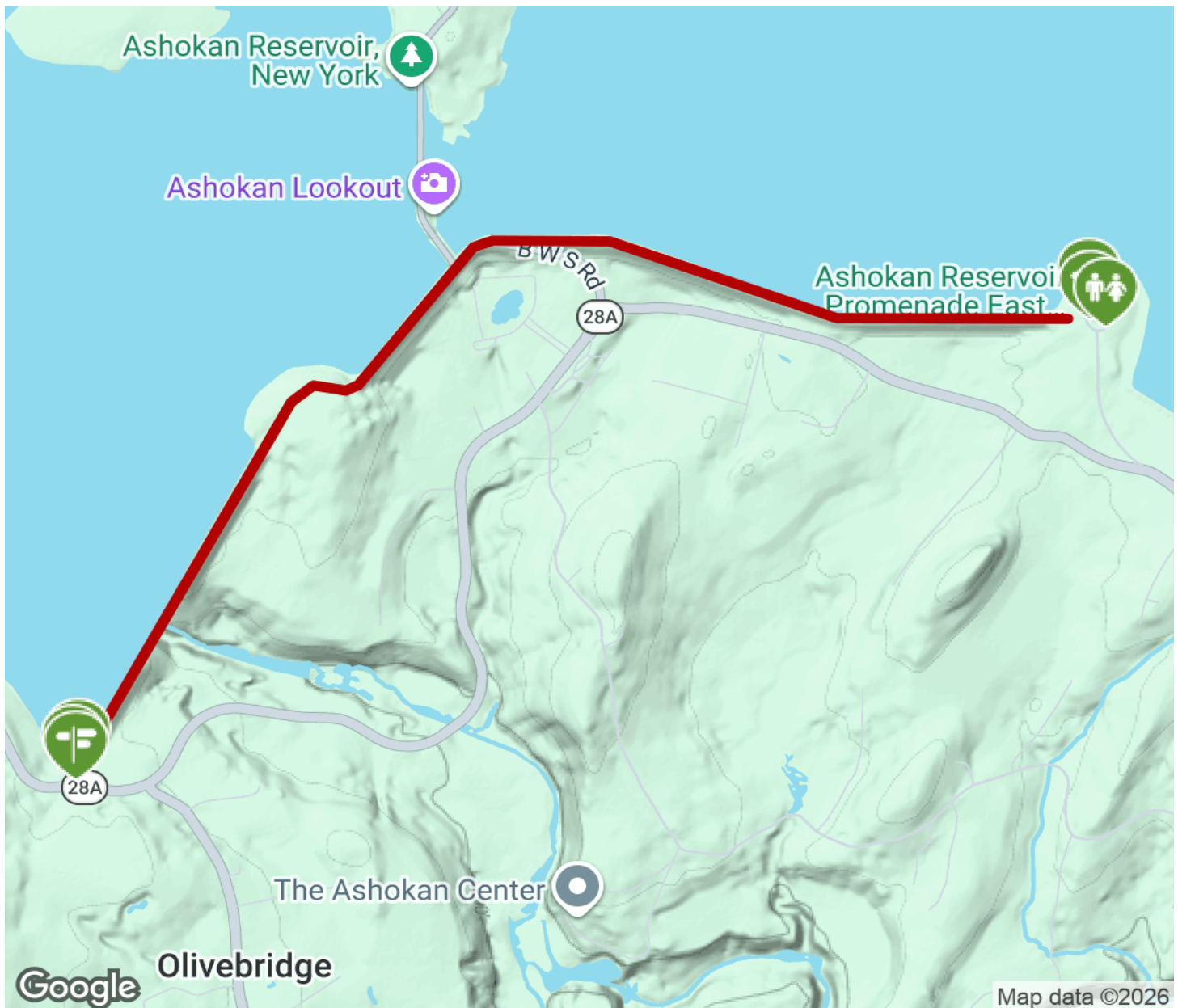
The Ashokan Reservoir Promenade runs between NY-28A (Olivebridge) and BWS Rd (Kingston), both of which offer parking.
